LEAGUE FINAL STANDING SHEETS

Please remember to always forward a copy of your league final standing sheet to the Area Secretary, BRIAN LANGFORD, 12, FORGE LANE, GRAVESEND. This mandatory requirement applies to each completed league season, whether Winter or Summer.

DIRECT TO B.T.B.A.

A number of items used to be sent to the Area Secretary. This system changed some time ago but old habits die hard it seems. Please note that all LEAGUE SANCTION APPLICATIONS, ALL MEMBERSHIP CARDS BOTH BLUE AND WHITE, FORMS LK103, NATIONAL AWARD FORMS must now go direct to Head Office at 19, CANTERBURY AVENUE, ILFORD, ESSEX. For the Award Forms or any correspondence that requires an answer DO NOT FORGET A STAMPED AND ADDRESSED ENVELOPE. If you haven't received your award badges it is possible that you forgot the envelope. None can be forwarded without it due to postage charges. Badges are 25p and chevrons 10p.

LEAGUE FUNDS INSURANCE

The B.T.B.A. Insurers no longer require to be notified of league funds providing that the total held at the bank during any one calendar year doesn't exceed £500. However notification must be given of amounts between £500 and £1,000 indicating the dates in the year when the funds reach this amount. The Insurance Company will not now give cover for sums in excess of £1,000 and any leagues where the total will exceed £1,000 should make their own arrangements for the balance.
