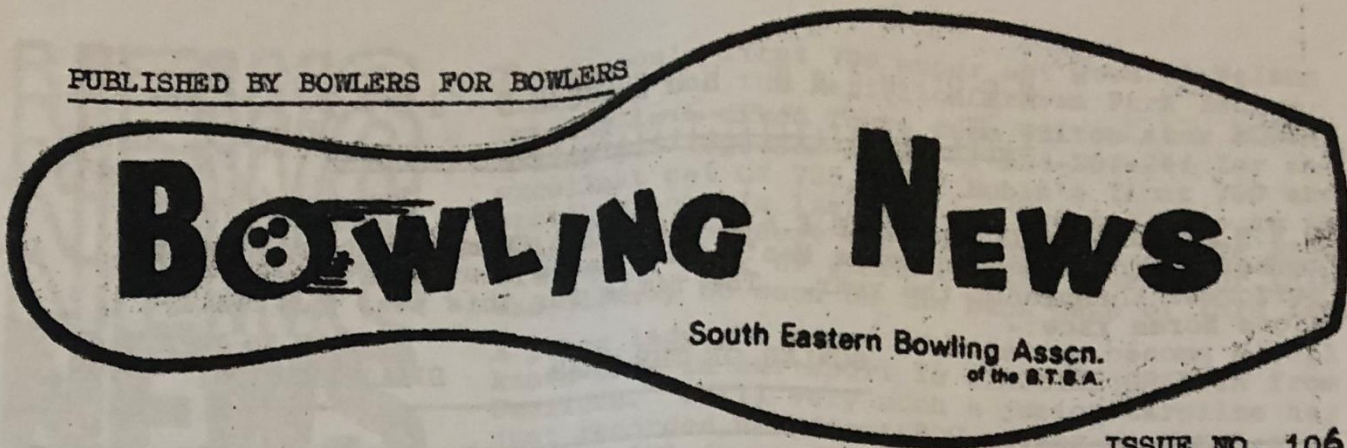

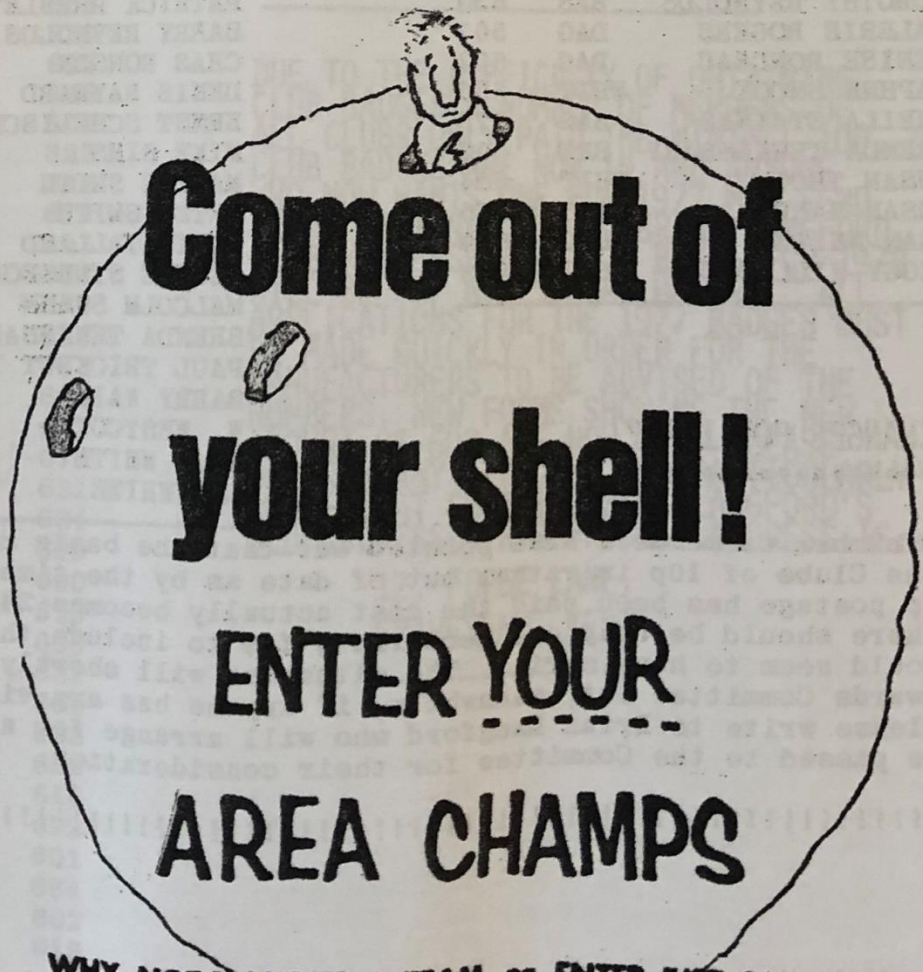

The remaining places are filled by the highest averages from the entry forms submitted for All Events.

This means that the county organisers for Essex and Kent - ALAN SAMUELS and BUZZ MORRISON - must arrange their trials very quickly. At least this year we have been made aware of the qualifying dates for the event. The qualifying rounds will take place on 18th June and 20th August and the finals on 14th and 15th October 1978. With Essex men being the current champions and the Kent men having their best ever year in 1977 - come on the ladies!!!!

Congratulations to SEBA Bowler of the Year BILLY PRESTON on retaining his Bexleyheath Bowler of the Year title. Rolling against the other nine finalists on a head to head 10 game match play format Billy rolled a fine tournament average of 201 for the day. Runner up was STEVE CARNALL. The ladies event - holder LESLEY POTTER - will be reported in the next issue of Bowling News.

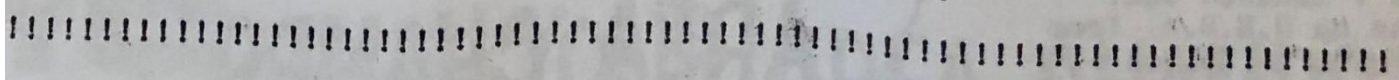
