MAY AT CLIFTONVILLE

It took every weekend for the whole of the month of May to complete the 1978 South Eastern Bowling Association's annual showcase, the 16th Area Championships. On Cliftonville's 12 lanes well over 3,000 games were bowled before all the new champions could be declared and before it was known the final whereabouts of a record prize fund - without sponsorship of any kind - of over £1,000.00!

As always some bowlers were in form, some were not, some thought they were but scored poorly and others considered themselves lucky to appear in the prize listings. Nothing new here but a number of new names appear as Area Champions, notably local player JOHN BARNES with an unbeatable 2001 handicap all events total, JUNE LEAPER of Southend who took the ladies scratch all events, ROY HUDSON from Bexleyheath with a fine scratch 626 to win the singles title, TONY KITCHING and KEITH HODGE also from Bexleyheath who won both scratch and handicap doubles crowns with 1200 actual and 1336 with handicap added and BRENDA TEWKESBURY, again from Bexleyheath, with a handicap total of 681 for the ladies singles title. Local girl JILL BALDWIN won the ladies scratch singles and proved this to be no flash in the pan when she added the S.E.B.A. Masters title to complete a fine Championships. Dagenham's ANDY MAYNARD is the new regular handicap singles holder on 694.

Repeat winners this year were JEAN CUMMINGS, ANNE SIMMONS, JANET MORRISON, LESLEY POTTER and PHIL RUSSELL and the team events were captured by MARTELLO from Walton, the CLIFTONVILLE ALL STARS and the SOUTHEND LADIES who took both scratch and handicap events.

A four weekend affair taxed the resources of the organisers to some extent but BRIAN LANGFORD was ever present and again did a fine job with the scheduling and general arrangements. JOHN CUDMORE handled the scoreboard in fine style and 'Our Pres' TED SHRIMPTON was in charge of registration. All the other helpers were too numerous to mention but our annual thanks go out to them for without all those who work for the Area at this very busy time the tournament could never take place. Most of what takes place is, for the most part, taken for granted but the smoothness of an operation this size only comes about with considerable organising ability and expertise and not a little self control!

Next year is again the turn of Essex to stage the largest Area tournament in the country. It could be WALTON ON NAZE, it could be SOUTHEND ON SEA. A number of things have to be considered before a final decision is made. Either way it will be a success. You the SEBA member will ensure that!
