

## 2nd Annual SEBA Junior Championships

The Second Annual S.E.B.A. Championships were held at Dagenham on the 16th Feb 1980. The same format was adopted, being a scratch competition over 3 games with classified entry on total mixed average. The Trios event for the 'BASILDON TROPHY' had an entering average of 420 and the doubles event, for which permanent trophies are to be awarded, was divided into three divisions with entering averages of 240, 280, & 320.

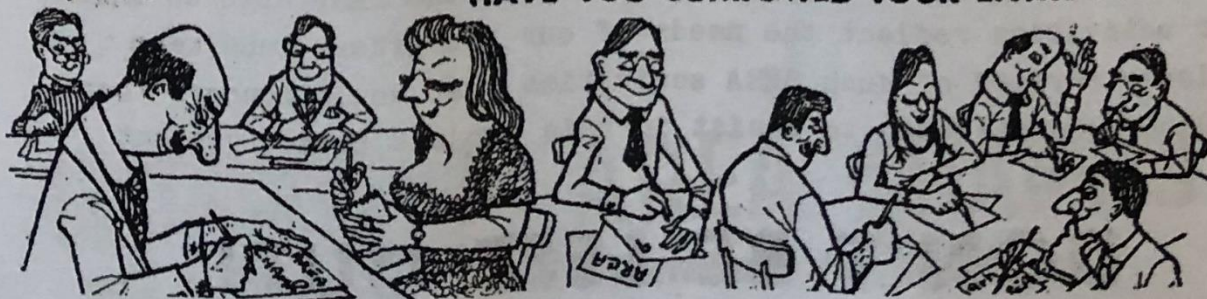
The Tournament attracted an entry of 88 bowlers from 5 centres. For the second year the TRIOS event was won by a team from BEXLEYHEATH with a total of 1399, the team being ROB GRANT, KEVIN HARRIS, and ANDY HIGSON. Only 4 pins behind in second place also from BEXLEYHEATH were VIC LEWIS, DAVID PENFOLD, and KEVIN BYHURST. Third with 1357 were a team from the home centre, ALPHONSO FERROL, RICHARD MOULD and JHON JOYCE.

The prizes in the DOUBLES event were spread around but in the lower average division, ELAINE LODGE came away with a second consecutive first place, partnering CHRISTOPHER TOMS both from BEXLEYHEATH. In second place COLIN BARTLETT and IAN EASTERN from DAGENHAM, with JOHN SHEAD and JASON MULLER from BASILDON third. The DOUBLES 280 ave division the winners were from WHITSTABLE, TREVOR TAYLOR and JACKIE JOHNS. Tied for second place, and divided by scratch scores, in second place JOHN JOYCE and RICHARD MOULD from DAGENHAM with DENESE KNAPP and KEVIN HARRIS of BEXLEYHEATH. The high average doubles went to MICK READY and ALPHONSO FERROL from DAGENHAM with 1048 from CHRISTENE LODGE and TERRY MUNSON of BEXLEYHEATH (1033) they had a tremendous battle on the same lanes with MARTIN PAYNE and MARK PRESLEY of BASILDON (1018) who finished third.

Awards for the high game in each division went to CHRISTOPHER TOMS and KEITH WEBB from BASILDON. SEAN PURCELL from WHITSTABLE, and TERRY MUNSON of BEXLEYHEATH with the day's high game of 235.

An excellent day's bowling with everyone looking forward to next year.
