In second place CCLIN BARTLETT and IAN EASTERN from DAGENHAM, with JOHN SHEAD and JASON MULLER from BASILDON third. The DCUBLES 290 ave division the winners were from WHITSTABLE, THEVOR TAYLOR and JACKIE JOHNS. Tied for second place, and divided by scratch scores, in second place JOHN JOYCE and RICHARD MOULD from DAGENHAM with DENESE KNAPP and KEVIN HARRIS of BEXLEYHEATH. The high average doubles went to MICK READY and ALPHONSO FERROL from DAGENHAM with 1048 from CHRISTENE LODGE and TEFRY MUNSON of BEXLEYHEATH (1033) they had a tremendous battle on he same lanes with MARTIN PAYNE and MARK PRESLEY of BASILDON (1018) who finished third.

Awards for the high game in each division went to CHRISTOPHER TOMS and KEITH WEBB from BASILDON. SEAN PURCELL FROM WHITSTABLE, and TERRY MUNSON of BEXLEYHEATH with the day's high game of 235.




