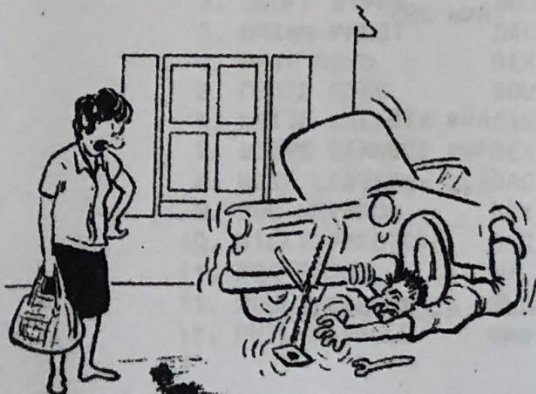

## BEXLEYHEATH BONANZA

18 This year, the S.E.B.A. CHAMPIONSHIPS reached it's age of majority - time for celebrations, and we had a BALL, the guests included 84 TEAMS, 334 SINGLES, 198 DOUBLES and a prize fund of £1266.35p. Every one wanted to join the action, and action there was - pins fell - scores went on to the leader board - ANN FINCH from WALTON won the LADIES HANDICAP SINGLES 134 - 221 - 235 - 590 scratch, 716 with handicap a new record. PAULINE DENHAM held the record previously from 1972 with 697. ANN went on to take the LADIES HANDICAP ALL EVENTS with 2006 another record, defeating 1944 by VICKEY TIMMS in 1972. WELL BOWLED ANN. PAULINE & VICKEY not discouraged by losing their records to ANN bowled their way on to the leader board, PAULINE with DORRIE BROWN from WHITSTABLE won the LADIES SCRATCH & HANDICAP DOUBLES, DORRIE scored 497, PAULINE 553 a total of 1050, a handicap total of 1274. VICKEY TIMMS with the MAIDS - of - KENT from CLIFTONVILLE, SUE JENKINS, JOAN COLE, ANN SIMMONS and JILL BALDWIN with 2408 from JOAN NUTT's team FALMER 'B' from SOUTHEND - 2405, just three pins over 150 frames! Staying with the ladies, DARENTH TAVERNERS from BEXLEYHEATH led by PEGGY HAMMOND supported by VAL YEATES, CHRIS HOWELL, BERYL DRURY, and PAT OVERY won the LADIES HANDICAP TEAM with 3005. POPPY COPE left her duties behind the bar bowled - 208-222-172 a total of 602 to win the LADIES SCRATCH SINGLES. JILL BALDWIN bowled 513 SINGLES, 585 DOUBLES, 566 TEAM to win the LADIES SCRATCH ALL EVENTS 1664. The regular section leader board changed squad by squad until the last day. RAY HOOK & PHIL RUSSELL scored 589 & 676 a tournament record 1265 for the SCRATCH DOUBLES. RAY had the pleasure of beating 1248 he had set with DAVE MABERLEY in 1974. The only record to fall in the regular section this year. The last day almost went to SCHLITZ ALL STARS with team members featured right across the board. REGULAR SCRATCH TEAM 2746. The HANDICAP TEAM prize went to a fine performance by the KNIGHTS from BASILDON, CHRIS PAIN 527, MALCOLM YULE 609, RON KEEBLE 537, BARRY GREENLAND 505 and KEITH PAIN 544 - 2722 scratch, 3113 with handicap. KEITH CREAMER from DAGENHAM scored 170-252- 201- for 628 scratch, 714 handicap for the HANDICAP SINGLES.



KEN STURGEON & BARRY WAIN from BEXLEYHEATH bowled 538-608 for the HANDICAP DOUBLES with 1339. Only one pin from JOHN DISBURY & BRIAN PECK, and only four pins from PHIL RUSSELL & RAY HOOK. Last but not least TREVOR YOUNG, SCRATCH SINGLES. 213-227- 218 to a total of 658. After we had finished we retired to the club to enjoy the hospitality provided by POPPY COPE and her staff through the long hours we spent at BEXLEYHEATH. # S.E.B.A. MASTERS



Sunday the 4th May at 5.30pm saw the duel of the S.E.B.A. MENS and LADIES MASTERS. Taking up their positions was BOB CLARKE, CLIVE COLE, KEITH HODGE, JOHN MILLS, TERRY SAUNDERS, BARRY MEMMOTT, BILL PRESTON, and PAUL SCOTTOW. Ladies, SHEILA WHITE, JANET MORRISON, JAN HODGE, DEBBIE SMITH, JILL BALDWIN, and JULIAN COPE as a pacer. - Battle commenced; CLIVE COLE 435 after two games, not far behind PAUL SCOTTOW 429 including 235 the highest game. Third BILLY PRESTON. After three games the 1-2-3- order was BILL PRESTON 653, PAUL SCOTTOW 644, CLIVE COLE 628: In the fourth and fifth games BARRY MEMMOTT bowled 221-212, BOB CLARKE 206-211 closing the gap between them and the leading three. KEITH HODGE, JOHN MILLS, and TERRY SAUNDERS were finding the going difficult averaging 183-165-181 after five games: One game to go - BARRY MEMMOTT 1025, PAUL SCOTTOW 1016, BOB CLARKE 1003. fourth BILLY PRESTON 998. Last Game, PAUL and BARRY bowling within sight of one and other on lanes 24 - 25. BILLY further along on lane 19. BARRY and PAUL locked in combat whilst BILLY was heading steadily toward a last game of 213 supported by his fan club. LAST FRAME; BARRY one spare away from victory - bowled - it's heavy toward the head pin, and leaves the 4-6-10 SPLIT - bowls again, takes the 6-10. BARRY lost the MASTERS to BILLY PRESTON 1211, second BARRY MEMMOTT 1203, third PAUL SCOTTOW 1201. The atmosphere was electric, thank you all for a GRAND FINISH.

The LADIES provided surprises and dramas, JILL BALDWIN opened with 192, followed by 158 ! JAN HODGE 178-180, SHEILA WHITE 175- 190. The position after three games - JAN HODGE 543, SHEILA WHITE 536, JILL BALDWIN 516. Fourth game Jan bowled a disastrous 147, SHEILA a steady 176. JILL making up ground 192. Fifth game and JILL found trouble again 152, fortunes had changed from game to game. One game to go SHEILA WHITE 901, was it her turn to run in to trouble ? JAN HODGE 884, could she make up the seventeen pins between her and SHEILA ? JILL BALDWIN 860, could she make two hundred plus and catch the front runners ? JANET MORRISON and DEBBIE SMITH just out of touch with 926-793. Final game; SHEILA avoided trouble, made sure of spares, and let the strikes take care of them selves for 176. JAN HODGE produced some of her earlier form, needed just one more double to win. She reduced the deficit to nine pins with 184, and finished second. JANET MORRISON finished third with the HIGH GAME of 222. JILL BALDWIN 180 finished fourth. There ended the 1979 S.E.B.A. MASTERS.
