1981 appears to be the year the Club Tournament Dies!!!

To date we have only received one entry! Last year when I prepared the League Sanctioned Kits I recall enclosing Club entry forms, am I to assume they have been lost in transit? Therefore explaining why so few entries have been received. I admit the Tournament usually scheduled for the new year has yet to be staged, and the Badges have not been available since 1977. Not A Happy Tale. Our search for a Badge Manufacturer has proved successful, but the amount of money required to purchase our requirements is prohibitive,

for example:- from our latest quote

Before you say Well? I will explain.

There are four Club Badges 200-500-550 & 600. Therefore if we were to order at 52p each we would be committing £1040.00, and receive 2000 Badges. More realistic would be to order 250 @ 73p = 1000 Badges at a cost of £730.00. Several problems now arise, our total income from membership fees 1980/81 was only £1000.00, and £730 represents a considerable proportion of our income, were we to expend £730 on Badges there would be no Bowling News, for those who comment there are not many now! The cost of each issue is £35.00.

There are several alternatives.

(A) Advance sales of badges, if we were to receive £500.00 in advance sales from Club members, we could proceed. To date we have approx £100 in advance sales, if you the members were to remit 80p per badge you require all would be well.

(B) We could increase the SEBA FEE to 5 or 10p and increase our income, for we are not free from inflation. our costs are at a minimum for labour, the Area Secretary received £300 approx last year for expenses, all other manual labour was given free by SEBA Council Members
