Second was JAN HODGE. LADIES HANDICAP SINGLES first SHEILA WHITE, second CHRIS HOWELL: Squad 1a and SHEILA continued her winning ways, accompanied by JAN HODGE they won the LADIES SCRATCH & HANDICAP DOUBLES. On to the LADIES TEAMS; CHAOS won the HANDICAP & SCRATCH TITLE - PAT GORDON, DENESE KNAPP, DOT EDWARDS, VERA ROPER & CHRISTINE LODGE. Second in the Ladies Handicap team was ENTERPRISE LADIES - SUE CASSIDY, LORRAINE LOGAN, PAT WEBSTER, CHRIS PEACOCK & MARG LAZARUS: The message that records were being broken reached JEFF DAVIS & ALAN KIRK bowling in squad two, they scored 1269 scratch, 1373 with handicap to win the REGULAR SCRATCH & HANDICAP DOUBLES, with a NEW CHAMPIONSHIP RECORD in both sections. 'THE CLAN' shall gather again next year at WHITSTABLE for the 20th SEBA ANNUAL CHAMPIONSHIPS. SEE YOU ALL THERE.

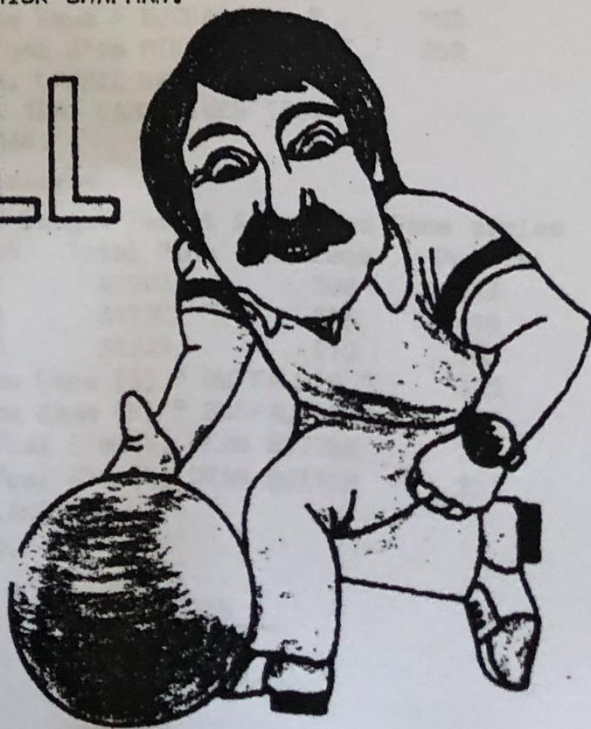
