



Junior Inter-County Championships 1982

There was a record entry of 18 boys teams and 13 girls teams in the Junior Inter-County Championships held at Airport Bowl in November. All the Trophies were donated by the sponsors — Champion Awards and Presentation of 113 High Street, Wealdstone, Middlesex.

Decided on a 6 game scratch total, the boys 5 person event was won by Essex after a close fought battle with Middlesex. The Middlesex Team had a close lead after the first series which they extended after the fourth game but started losing ground in the fifth game. Essex finished magnificently with a sixth game of 997, the individual scores being Mark Presley 215, Rob Hobart 209, Mick Clack 206, John Shead 195 and Phil Wainwright 179. The other two members of the Squad were Tony Pavellin and Chris Turner.

James Lambert of Middlesex recorded the High Game of the day with 254 which was one of 37 games over 200 bowled by the boys during the day. London finished in third place.

The girls event with four person teams was won by County Durham after a very close battle with Warwickshire and Hertfordshire. The Durham Squad was Denise Thompson, Susan Baker, Joanne Stametti, Paula Brigham, Jackie Baker and Jane Crouch. The prize for the Girls High Game went to Tracy Westbrook from Warwickshire.

The success of the Mens and Ladies Teams in the County Championships is obviously rubbing off on the Juniors as in the Mens event Middlesex won from Essex and here we have the Boys from the same Counties battling it out only for Essex to finish on top. With the Ladies and Girls all is success in County Durham.

The Fourth AMF - Humber Junior Championships

Southend sent five youngsters to Crawley to compete in the championship events. As the championships are taking place in two centres simultaneously Leeds and Crawley were in contact throughout the day comparing scores to determine the National Winners.

Robert Hobart (15) won the Senior Singles with 553 pins and teamed up with Tracey Thorogood (also 15) to place second in the Senior Doubles with 967 pins.

Mike Clack (17) and Mark Presley (16) then wrapped up the Graduate Doubles, winning with 1044.

Onto the Four-Person team event, Robert Hobart, Tracey Thorogood, John Shead and Mark Presley threw 1947 pins to win the Team Championships comfortably.

Five events contested, three gold and one silver won, that can't be bad. SEBA Master Mark Presley averaged 195.4 over 9 games finishing with a 232 + 223 + 182 for a 637 set in the team event.

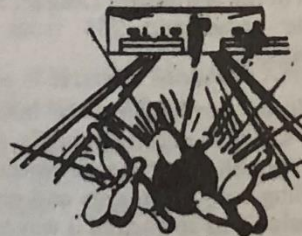

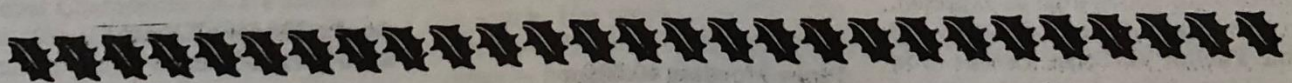
