Steve Hart averaging 130 scored 160, 146, 246 for a 552 series. Brian Green 267, 190, 213 for 670. Bob Button bowled his first 600 series with 228, 206, 197 for 631. Well done, Bob. Friday Night New Beach Cash League, and Mervyn Hogg bowls a 247 game. Debbie Heffer hits her personal best series 187, 212, 238 for 637. Not to be left out husband Peter spared the 4-6 split a few weeks later, (should not have left it, should he Deb?) Brian Green hit another high series with 212, 226, 234 for 672.

New Beach Doubles Friday nights. 6/4/84 Paul Scottow and Nigel Goss set a new House Record for the doubles series with 1317. One week later set a new doubles single game record 522. Paul scored 245, Nigel 277. Their series was 1256.

One week was to pass and they had games of 429, 414, 411 for a 1254. Paul's league average over 45 games is 202, and Nigel's over 42 games is 196. Incidentally, they are at the top of the league by 25 points.

It must be the sea air at Walton that produces their high scores, 11/5/84, The Pro Shop: Paul Scottow, Peter Grant, Terry Hewitt, John Mills, in the New Beach Cash League scored a four person team series of 2414, and on the same night Harry Gallant hit 629, Brian Green 636 and Bob Button a 237

On the 29th of June the Pro Shop was drawn against the Jaguars, and Nigel Goss was included in the Pro Shop team at the last moment, and what a night it turned out to be.

Nigel hit his first 700 series with games of 206, 254, 279 for 739, and helped his team to change three house records. The Pro Shop in their second game scored 922, taking a four person team game that had stood since 1968 by the Lakenheath Flyers.

This record was not to last long for the Pro Shop hit 943. They then broke their own house record for a four person team series by 186 pins to set a new house record of 2696.

In the New Beach Doubles on the 1st June, Paul Scottow and Nigel Goss hit team games of 440, 437, 461 for a new house record series of 1376, in the doubles.

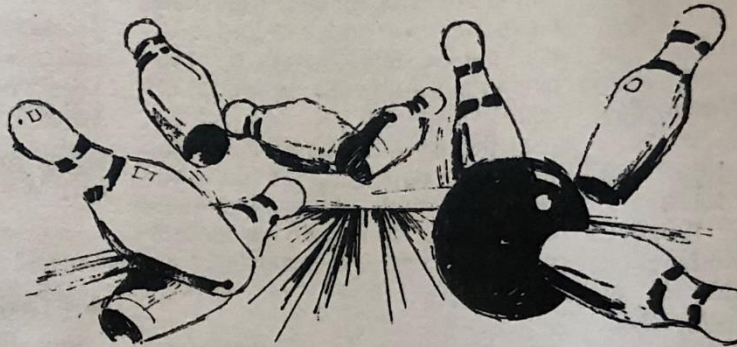
Well done team, we are proud of you, for it's the first time one Company has featured at the top of each section of these Champion-
