## What is a Foul?

I often hear arguments between bowlers as to what is a FOUL, this seems to be the most misunderstood rule we have in bowling so I have tried here to clarify the foul as defined by the B.T.B.A.

A foul is committed when the ball is legally delivered and any part of the bowler's person comes in contact with the lane, foul line or portions of the division boards, walls, posts or uprights which are on a line with or extends beyond the foul line.

The foul line, in effect, extends clear across the building, up the walls and along the ceiling and should be painted on any part of the structure which can be touched by a bowler.

A ball is legally delivered when it leaves the bowler's possession and crosses the foul line into the playing territory.

A bowler is subject to the foul rule after every legal delivery and until he or another player is in a position to make a succeeding delivery. The player shall be charged with a foul whether the ball is in the pit or on the way back to the ball rack if he enters the foul area before he or another bowler is in position to bowl again.

The foul line extends in an unbroken line across the building including aisles and up walls. Therefore a bowler who steps into an aisle beyond the foul line or touches the wall beyond the foul line has committed a foul. If a bowler's foot crosses the foul line on an adjacent lane, it is a foul. And as we all should know if any part of the bowler's body touches the lane beyond the foul line, even if it does not activate the automatic detecting device, it is a foul.

The following are NOT FOULS.

When foreign objects drop from the bowler's pocket on to or over the foul line and no part of the bowler's person touches on or across the foul line. The bowler must tell the opposing team captain or foul judge before retrieving the fallen object.

A foul is not committed when the bowler enters the foul area but retains possession of the ball. The bowler has not fouled because he has not executed a legal delivery.

Everything on the approach side is fair territory for the bowler. He may prevent a foul by holding onto posts, ball returns or the wall on his side of the foul line.
