Bowlmasters 1 v Splitz 2 - It hasn't been "Bowlmasters" season so far, for after a good start they fell away badly and "Splitz" who don't need asking twice these days, fairly gobbled up the two points with obvious glee.

Demolition 2 v The Youngsters 1 - Last weeks leaders "The Youngsters" lost 2-1 at the hands of "Demolition" for whom Kevin Williams chipped in a 550 series. With an extra point for bonus "Demolition" jump into 5th place

Manhattans 3 v S & S Motors 0 - Not as clear cut as the score suggests but "Manhattans" assisted by a 590 series from John Smith just had that edge to secure all the points plus one for bonus. They now move up to 2nd place tucked in nicely behind the leaders, but there's a tough one next week!!

Deadly Doughnuts 3 v Kamikazi Trio 0 - The "Trio" felt the "wrath of Cook" in the form of Don who put together a 598 series and with both ladies making their average the "Doughnuts" claimed a massive haul of over 5 points with bonus. This win puts them once again back into top spot.

Bowlmasters 3 v Capos 0 - "Bowlmasters" are beginning to "stir" having picked up 12 points over the past four weeks. Mike Luckhurst amassed a series of 668 but was still heard to say that he "lost his line in the last".

High Rollers 2 v On-Strike 1 - A sudden reverse as "On-Strike" slaughtered the

"Rollers" in the first game, by a massive 1 pin, only to be caught in the opposite situation in the second to lose - yes, by 1 pin. The third game was an anticlimax as the "Rollers" took it with ease.

Heavy Impact 2 v Splitz 1 - This match played in advance on a Saturday was, judging by the scores, sadly missing in league atmosphere and subsequently both sides lost bonus but did salvage some pins, "Heavy Impact" 24 - "Splitz" 36.

High Rollers 3 v Capos 0 - A fine win for the "Rollers" for with the 3 points plus a further 3 points bonus it lifts them into second place in the table. A seasons best of 608 for Kevin Stocker paved the way for the "Rollers" who proved far too strong for "Capos" who now find themselves in the "bargain basement".

Kamikaze Trio 2 v Splitz 1 - Another good result for the "Trio" who also added 3 bonus points to their total and moved up into 5th place. "Splitz" had another good total to make over 2 points bonus which lifts them off the bottom rung.

The Youngsters 3 v Heavy Impact 0 - Apart from a close first game "The Youngsters" were good value for their three points and with the help of a bonus point they are once again back in top spot by a slender margin of just 21 pins.

Bowlmasters 2 v Manhattans 1 - Closest match of the night here with only 1 pin between the teams after 3 games. Off to a flyer "Manhattans" could not maintain their effort and surrendered the last two games. Mike Luckhurst was again amongst the 200's with a 618 series closely followed by John Smith with a 599 series.

S & S Motors 2 v Demolition 1 - After sharing the first two games "Demolition" fell away to concede the last. In a comparatively low scoring match "Motors" just had the edge and managed to make bonus for the first time in 4 weeks whilst "Demolition" on the other hand lost nearly 1 point.

On Strike 2 v Deadly Doughnuts 1 - With a high game of only 170 amongst the teams it turned out to be very close in the end but both teams lost bonus in the process.

Week 15

Kamikazi Trio 3 v The Youngsters 0 - By virtue of this win, plus 3 bonus points, the "Trio" leap-frog into top spot in the league. A fine opening game of 638 scratch gave them the boost they needed. Don't think that the "Youngsters" bowled badly, they didn't, their scores would have beaten 9 out of the remaining 10 teams but it just wasn't their night.

Manhattans 3 v High Rollers 0 - A comparatively easy win for the "Manhattans" to move into second place. The "Rollers" were unable to recreate their form of last week.

Heavy Impact 3 v Deadly Doughnuts 0 - A very close contest here with the odd spare making all the difference in two games. Two good performances from Pete Woodward, who has just returned this season after a long lay-off, to put together a 591 series, whilst Gill Cook of the "Doughnuts" rolled way above her average with a 519 series to secure a bonus point for her team.

Bowlmasters 3 v Demolition 0 - The "Masters" continued their recent form by easily taking the three points on offer. They are now well in contact with the pack and their next match against the league leaders should be interesting to say the least.

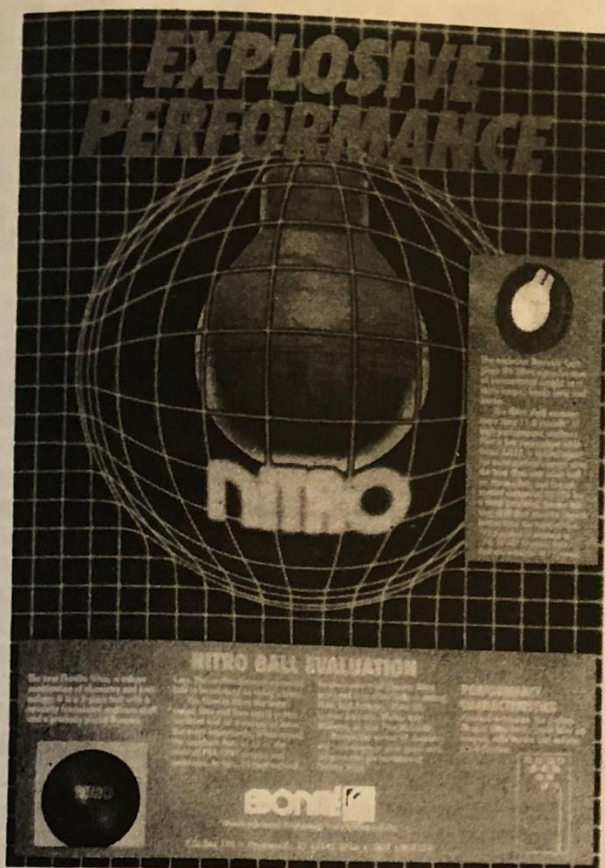

**PAENG WINS THIRD WORLD CUP!
 GERMANY'S MARTINA BECKEL IS
 LADIES' VICTOR AT LE MANS**

Paeng Nepomuceno of the Philippines became the first three-time winner in the 28 year history of the AMF Bowling World Cup when he defeated Achim Grabowski of Germany, 210-195, before 1,800 screaming fans in the elegant Le Forum convention centre at Le Mans, France.

Germany's Martina Beckel beat Argentina's Laura Lanzavecchia, 221-179, to win the woman's crown on a chilly grey November afternoon.

Nepomuceno, 35, a six foot two Pro Shop owner from Manila, and Beckel, 33, a bespectacled Frankfurt Bank Manager, are both lefties. The two dominated most of the week long tournament at 18 lane Bowling du Mans, finally earning the top seeded position in the step ladder finals played on two specially constructed lanes in Le Forum. All the other finalists were right-handers.

Nepomuceno, who was making his 11th World Cup appearance, is the tournament's first three time winner, having won previously in 1976 and 1980. As his father and constant coach, Angel, reminded the press, Paeng may be the only athlete in any sport to win a world title in three decades. Beckel, the current FIQ World Championships singles champion, previously finished second and third in the World Cup.

Lanzavecchia, who placed third in the semifinals, defeated Mariea Ramirez of Costa Rica, 226-206, and Cathy Dorin of the United States, 189-157, to earn her shot at the women's leader. In the opening match of the women's finals Ramirez beat Grace Young of Singapore 218-196.

Taiwan's Cheng-Ming Yang stopped Australia's Mike Muir in the men's opener, 189-138, but lost 265-215, to Grabowski. The 26 year old German right-hander then edged Sweden's Par Svenson, 178-176, to earn his berth for the title game.

Beckel averaged nearly 210 for the weeklong tournament, and Nepomuceno was a few sticks short of 230, by far the best overall performance in history.

But the tournament was spectacular in other ways, too. It opened with a parade of 60 antique cars, featured many events around the famous Le Mans race track and ended with a spectacular finale in a public arena.

The 29th World Bowling Cup will be staged at a 24 lane centre in Cape Town, South Africa, the southernmost city on the African continent. Bent Petersen, Vice President of AMF bowling Inc., and host proprietor Gerald Paluzzi, who is also an officer of the Tenpin Bowling Association of South Africa, made the announcement at the victory party which concluded the Le Mans festivities.

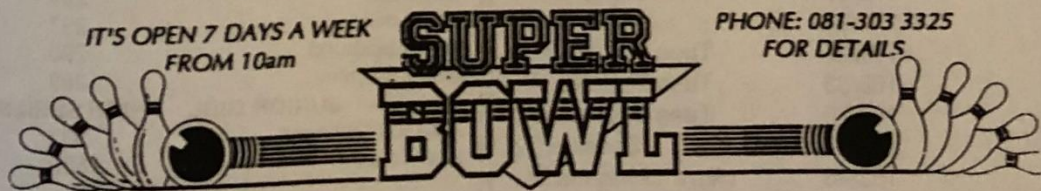
