# WHITSTABLE YBC by Martin Beale

The Whitstable YBC runs a league of four person teams from September to July - approximately 40 weeks.

At the half-way stage, one team - "Flintstones" (Andrew Senior, Tim Beale, Nathan Clark and Robert Gore) - appears to be dominating.

Flintstones' record is indeed impressive. With an 81% win rate at an average of 638, they also hold the season's high series scratch (2069), high series handicap (2273) and high game scratch (733 which they have achieved twice).

The individual members hold the league's top three boys' scratch individual highs - for series we have Tim Beale with 589, Nathan Clark with 561 and Andrew Senior with 560. For games, Tim (again) leads with a 242, then Nathan with a 235. Tim also recorded the third highest score of 226 (equalled by Nathan in the Margate Inter-Centre tournament in January), and Andrew Senior has the fourth highest with a 224. Tim also holds

high series handicap (646) and high game handicap (260).

In second place and fighting hard comes "Shankers" (Jonathan Whorlow, Darren Hatton, Samantha Cooper and Chris Hall). Jonathan and Darren are both on form, turning in regular 500 series. Samantha has just been awarded her BTBA Instructors (Phase 1) certificate after attending the instructors' course held at Beckton in January - very well done, Sam! Chris is also finding his form, turning in a nice 513 series recently. Have they left it too late to put the pressure on the Flintstones? Time will tell.

Whitstable is an unusual YBC in that it has a strong female presence (50% of the league members are girls). Many of the them are young newcomers to bowling, but are showing great promise, improving their averages regularly. They are determined that the boys won't have it all their own way. A trophy is presented each month to the bowler who improves his or her average by the most pins and in January, the top four "improvers" were all girls - Kim Hewett, Joanne and Pandora Symes and Rebecca Ward.

Rebecca has just celebrated her tenth birthday but was still one of our star performers at our Kent Inter-Centre Challenge, held at Margate in January. Her league average was just 69, so her handicap was helpful - exceptionally so when she turned in scores of 99, 85 and 156 (a super game) to give her 5th place in the Singles. Steve Hatt of Cliftonville was the Singles winner - his scratch series of 593 being the highest of the event (Ben Marsh of Margate recorded a 607 in the Doubles, however). Our own Mark Lovett pushed Steve hard with an excellent 204-183-196 for a 583 (net 667) to come in second.

The Doubles were closely contested - Ben's 607 not being enough to get his team into even the top ten. Just 96 pins separated the top five pairs - Steve Hatt (again) and Nigel Cruttenden (Clifton-ville) coming top of the pile with 1130 (net 1292). Whitstable's Darren Hatton and Jonathan Whorlow picked up 3rd with 1037 (net 1226) - just 8 pins behind the runners-up.

When it comes to close finishes, though, the Team game took some beating. Whitstable's "Oysters" - Jennifer Beale (166), Tim Beale (193), Nathan Clark (191) and Andrew Senior (192) - recorded a superb 742 (net 833) to be just pipped to the title by Cliftonville's "Surprise Guys" whose handicap advantage was sufficient to overhaul "Oysters" by 9 pins (649 net 842).

11-Year-old Jennifer Beale is currently our best-performing female bowler with a league average of 157. She has recently been awarded Canterbury & District Sports Advisory Council's Under-17 Sports Personality of the Year award for her bowling achievements in 1994, which was crowned by her taking the NAYBC Junior Girls' Masters title last October. In 1995, she and brother Tim participated in the Midland Junior Open, where - bowling as a Senior Boys' Doubles team - they came within 46 pins of that title with an excellent 1081. A Junior Girl winning a Senior Boys event? What a shock that would have been for the establishment! Jenny's 574 (including a 219) gave her the Junior Girls' High Game and High Series trophies (and a 172 average in the Under-14 Girls Merit Table, putting her in first place - for one week, anyway!).

Her high spot of the YBC year, however, came in December when she recorded a 199-218-211 series for a 628 - believed to be the third highest series in the history of Whitstable's YBC - behind lan Scammell's 673 in 1992 and Andrew Senior's 648 a year ago.

Andrew Senior was the first member of the YBC to score 10000 pins scratch in the league this season, in the second game of Week 20 - an excellent achievement. His current average of 173 is one of the highest recorded over an extended period within the YBC. In league and sanctioned tournaments this season, he has recorded no less than 14 200+ games and 24 500+ series. To put this into perspective, the second place 200+ scorers are Nathan Clark and Jennifer Beale, each with just 7, and the runner-up 500+ scorers are Nathan Clark and Tim Beale, each with 11.

Whilst on the subject of high scores, we must congratulate a whole host of members who have recorded personal bests this season - Tim Beale (242), Nathan Clark (235), Jennifer Beale (222), Darren Hatton (221) and Mark Lovett (220); Lisa Wraight and Jonathan Whorlow both came in with 214 on the very same day; Antony Cooper and Zoe Hards both got their "maiden" double centuries - 207; Andrew Wraight (average 126)

and Lisa Digby (average 113) both turned in brilliant 195s; Joe Cooper (183), Anne Perkins (175) and Kim Hewett (169); Kevin Franks - just 9 years old - a 167 then a 168; Luke Foxley, returning after a long lay-off, a superb 162; Rebecca Ward's 156 - it was only two weeks earlier that she scored her first century; Stuart Belchem - just 10 years old - 131 then 135, 136 and finally 150; Anna Symes (132), Rachel Thompson (114); Joanne Symes (103) and Pandora Symes (95). Well done to you all!
