#### Week 16

"Gentle Touch" with a 2-1 win over "S & S Motors" and over 2 points bonus move up two places to eighth well in touch with the mid-table pack. "S & S Motors" lost bonus but retain second place.

League leaders "Strikeforce" were given a run for the points by "Capos" and came away with a 2-1 win and a small bonus to move nine points clear at the top. "Capos" remain in sixth place well in touch with the chasing pack.

"Manhattans" with a 2-1 win over "Kamikaze Trio" move up three places to fifth well in touch with the top three. The "Trio" take the lift down to seventh spot.

Those sleeping giants "Bowmasters" awoke to take the first and second games before returning to hibernation and remain in eleventh place. "3 Under Par" picked up the remaining point but are still confined to the cellar.

"Ratners" helped themselves to 2 points against "Demolition" before wilting in the third, but remain in third spot. "Demolition" drop a place to tenth.

"Deadly Doughnuts" stuck to their task after losing the first game to "Heavy Impact" coming back to take the second and third games and move into fourth place. "Heavy Impact" drop two places to ninth.

#### Week 17

The scores certainly improved after the Christmas break with no fewer than 747

bonus pins being won by ten teams combined, the two not making bonus only dropped 9 pins between them so there is a lot of movement in the table to start the New Year.

Star movers of the week were the ladies of "Gentle Touch" who with a 2-1 win over league leaders "Strikeforce" and just over two bonus points jump four places from eighth to fourth after recording over ten points in the last three weeks. "Strikeforce" remain at the top of the league however with a substantial cushion of over eight points.

"Ratners" with a 2-1 win over "Deadly Doughnuts" and over 2½ bonus are chasing hard in third place and a few more weeks like that could be a surprise package. The "Doughnuts" came out with over two points with bonus but drop two places to sixth.

"Demolition" also scored well in defeating "Kamikaze Trio" 2-1 and collecting over two points bonus in the process to move up to eighth. The "Trio" just made their target but drop two places to ninth.

"Heavy Impact" just got the better of the "Manhattans" 2-1 in a very close match where there was only one pin in the overall. With nearly two bonus points each "Heavy Impact" move up to seventh and "Manhattans" remain in fifth.

Although losing 2-1 to "S & S Motors", "3 Under Par" came out on top thanks to two points bonus but they remain in the anchor position. "Motors" with their 2 points just manage to hold onto second spot by a few pins only.

"Bowmasters" outpointed "Capos" 2-1 but with only a small bonus failed to improve on their eleventh place. "Capos" tumbled down five places to tenth.

#### Week 18

"S & S Motors" with a 2-1 win over "Ratners" narrowed the gap between their second place and league leaders "Strikeforce". After two very close games that were shared one apiece the "Motors" put their foot down to secure the third. "Ratners" remain in third place.

"Gentle Touch", the current team of the moment, had another fine result with a 2-1 win over "Bowmasters" and over two points bonus. They remain in fourth place but with this result relegated "Bowmasters" to last place.

"Manhattans" maintain their recent good fortune with a 2-1 win over "Capos", to stay in fifth place and "Capos" stuck in tenth.

"Demolition" just had the handicap edge to outpoint "Heavy Impact" 2-1 and improve their position by two places to sixth. "Heavy Impact" remain in seventh place thanks to the last game they won by just two pins.

League leaders "Strikeforce" run up against trouble in the form of "3 Under Par" who took the first two games and only lost the last by three pins. "3 Under Par" squeeze out of the basement by a fraction of a pin.

In the final match, not particularly high scoring, "Kamikaze Trio" and "Deadly Doughnuts" shared the points with an unusual Tied Game.

#### Week 19

"Deadly Doughnuts" became the jumpers of the week with a near six point haul from their 3-0 victory over "S & S Motors". They move up four places from eighth to fourth to get amongst the chasing bunch. "S & S Motors" were lucky to only drop one place and are now in third spot.

"3 Under Par" with a 2-1 win over "Ratners" and a 2 point bonus considerably closed the gap between their eleventh place and tenth spot. "Ratners", although beaten, had over two points with bonus and move into second place.

In the Top v Bottom clash, leaders "Strikeforce", after taking the first game, narrowly lost the second, but were well beaten in the third as "Bowmasters" secured over three points with bonus thanks mainly to a 666 series from Mike Luckhurst. They still remain in the cellar but are closing the gap between them and the lower teams.

"Heavy Impact" had a useful 3-0 win over the "Kamikaze Trio" and with nearly a point bonus move up one place to sixth. The "Trio" were fortunate to remain in ninth place.

"Capos" stopped the recent good run by the "Gentle Touch" with a 3-0 win leaving "Capos" in tenth place and dropping the "Gentle Touch" down from fourth to fifth.

"Demolition" although defeating

"Manhattans" 2-1 drop a place to seventh but above "Manhattans" who dropped from fifth to eighth.

#### Week 20

On another uninspiring night for the league "Strikeforce" with a 2-1 win over "Manhattans" retained top spot but their cushion has developed a leak. "Manhattans" climb a place to seventh just outside the main chasing pack.

"Ratners", with a 3-0 win over "Capos" in an extremely low scoring match, continue to press the leaders whilst "Capos" fall two places to eleventh.

"Demolition" moved up two places after their 2-1 win over the "Deadly Doughnuts" and are now well amongst the chasing pack. The "Doughnuts" slipped a place to sixth but are still in contact with the chasers.

"Gentle Touch" climbed back to fourth after a 2-1 win over "Heavy Impact" who drop two places to eighth.

"3 Under Par" lifted themselves up a place to tenth following a 2-1 win over "Kamikaze Trio" who moved up one place.

"Bowmasters", despite a 2-1 win over "S & S Motors", failed to extricate themselves from the cellar but did pull back a few pins on the team just above them. "Motors" luckily hung onto third place with the aid of a couple of pins.

#### Week 21

"Ratners", with nearly four points including bonus edge ever closer to the leaders and can now with a good couple of weeks become a threat. "Heavy Impact" who were on the receiving end of a 663 series from Colin Ottaway retain their eighth place thanks to a 614 series from Paul Crundell.

Leaders "Strikeforce" with a 2-1 win over "S & S Motors" and over a point bonus maintained the consistent scoring rate and will take some beating. "S & S Motors" slip a place to fourth despite nearly a point bonus.

"Manhattans" with over four points including bonus climbed two places to fifth as a result of their 3-0 win over the "Doughnuts" who drop a place to seventh.

"Capos" change places with "3 Under

Par" to take over tenth after defeating them 2-1 leaving "3 Under Par" in eleventh.

"Bowmasters", languishing in the basement improved their pinfall slightly to creep up behind eleventh place after a 2-1 win over "Demolition" who drop a place to sixth.

"Gentle Touch" move up a place to third despite losing 2-1 to "Kamikaze Trio" who remain in ninth place

#### Week 22

"Bowmasters" returned to winning ways with a 2-1 victory over the "Manhattans" who were unlucky as their score would have beaten nine out of the other ten teams on the night! A 673 series from Mike Luckhurst was just the tonic "Bowmasters" needed to climb out of the basement - just wait till he finds his line!! "Manhattans" were rewarded with a move up to fourth place well amongst the pack.

League leaders "Strikeforce" were thwarted with a tie in the first game against the "Doughnuts" before powering away to take the second and third games and increase their lead at the top. The "Doughnuts" drop a place from seventh to eighth.

The "Kamikaze Trio" came up against second placed "Ratners" but in a low scoring match the "Trio" were the only team in it and came away with four points including bonus and leap three places to sixth. "Ratners" dropped to third after losing nearly three points bonus.

"Capos" had that tell tale sign of plenty of time with George - baggy trousers - that must have worked as they defeated "Heavy Impact" 3-0 after squeezing home by two pins in the first game, but they could not improve on their tenth place. The poor old "Heavies" lost a point bonus and fell three places to eleventh.

"Gentle Touch" cruised into second place following their 2-1 win over "3 Under Par" who were unceremoniously dumped in the basement as a result.

"S & S Motors" defeated "Demolition" 2-1 in another low scoring match but were unable to hang on to fourth place and dropped to fifth. "Demolition" also relinquished a place dropping from sixth to

seventh.

#### Week 23

It was all change as no fewer than 10 teams made a move either up or down. With a position night next week there are some intriguing fixtures.

League leaders "Strikeforce" play "Manhattans" following their 2-1 defeat by "Demolition" and "Manhattans" 3-0 hammering of "S & S Motors"

"Gentle Touch" will repeat last weeks match against "Ratners" that resulted in a 2-1 win in favour of the "Rats".

"Demolition", after their good win over "Strikeforce" take on the "Deadly Doughnuts" who put up a real fight before going down 2-1 to "Bowmasters".

"S & S Motors" drop two places and meet "Bowmasters" who were on the move again - up one place to eighth.

"Capos", after a 2-1 win over the "Kamikaze Trio", are paired against "Heavy Impact" who hand quite a battle with "3 Under Par" before taking two points.

In the final match "Kamikaze Trio", who were in sixth place last week, tackle "3 under Par" and will have their work cut out if they are to avoid ending up in the basement.

#### Week 25

High flyers this week were "S & S Motors" with a 3-0 win over "Capos", to catapult themselves from ninth to fourth with the aid of a 657 series from Mat Slade and 2 ½ points bonus. "Capos" drop from eighth to tenth as they record their lowest score of the season.

"Ratners" take over from "Manhattans" in second place after defeating them 2-1 with a useful 1½ points bonus, taking them to within two points of the leaders and guess who they are playing next week?

"Bowmasters" tied the last game with "Kamikaze Trio" and were spot on target but still lose a place and have to settle for seventh place. The "Trio" lost half a point to a minus bonus but retain eleventh place.

"Demolition" moved up two places to fifth after defeating "3 Under Par" 3-0 to join a pack of teams in mid-table. "3

Under Par" stay confined to the basement and are gradually losing contact.

"Heavy Impact" defeated leaders "Strikeforce" 2-1 in a low scoring affair, to move up to ninth place whilst "Strikeforce" lost half of their point to a minus bonus and are hanging onto the lead by the skin of their teeth.

"Gentle Touch" although defeating the "Deadly Doughnuts" 2-1 lose a place and drop to sixth whilst the "Doughnuts" took the lift down to eighth place.

#### Week 26

The "Rats" hit top spot with a 3-0 win over the former leaders "Strikeforce" plus an additional 2½ points bonus despite a valiant 628 series from Steve Saville for "Strikeforce" that could not prevent them slipping to third place.

"Bowlmasters" moved crisply into fifth place after crushing "Heavy Impact" 3-0 with Barbara Endicott doing the damage whilst rolling her maiden 600 series with a 613. The "Heavies" luckily hung on to ninth place by a mere 23 pins.

"S & S Motors" maintained their fourth place with a 3-0 win over the "Kamikaze Trio" squeezing home by just 4 pins in the last game. Mat Slade rolled his third 600 in as many weeks, this time a 613, to contribute towards 1½ points bonus. The "Trio" are going through a very rough patch but managed to cling to eleventh place.

"Manhattans" defeated the "Gentle Touch" 3-0, to take over second spot, in a low scoring match particularly for the ladies of "Gentle Touch" who drop to eighth as a result.

"Demolition", despite a 3-0 win over an illness hit "Capos" side, drop a place to sixth but it's getting very tight in the mid-table area. "Capos" to their credit managed to make their target and retain tenth place.

In the final match, "3 Under Par" defeated the "Deadly Doughnuts" 2-1 in another low scoring match but still remain in the basement. The "Doughnuts", although losing ½ point to a minus bonus, moved up a place to seventh.

#### Week 27

"Ratners" although depleted through illness and despite being beaten 2-1 by

"Bowlmasters" retained top spot still with their 4 point cushion. "Bowlmasters" moved up a place to fourth thanks to Mike Luckhurst's 636 series.

"Heavy Impact" cruised to a 3-0 win over "S & S Motors" and moved up a place to eighth. "S & S Motors" dropped a place to fifth despite Mat Slade's fourth 600+ series in as many weeks with a 617.

"Manhattans" remain in second place after missing an opportunity to close up on the leaders but were defeated 2-1 by "3 Under Par" who clambered out of the basement with glee.

"Strikeforce" inched past "Kamikaze Trio" 2-1 to retain third place. The "Trio" on the other hand end up in the basement by just over a point.

"Deadly Doughnuts" retained seventh place with a hard fought 2-1 win over "Capos" who also hung onto tenth place.

The remaining match between "Demolition" and "Gentle Touch" was "bugged off".

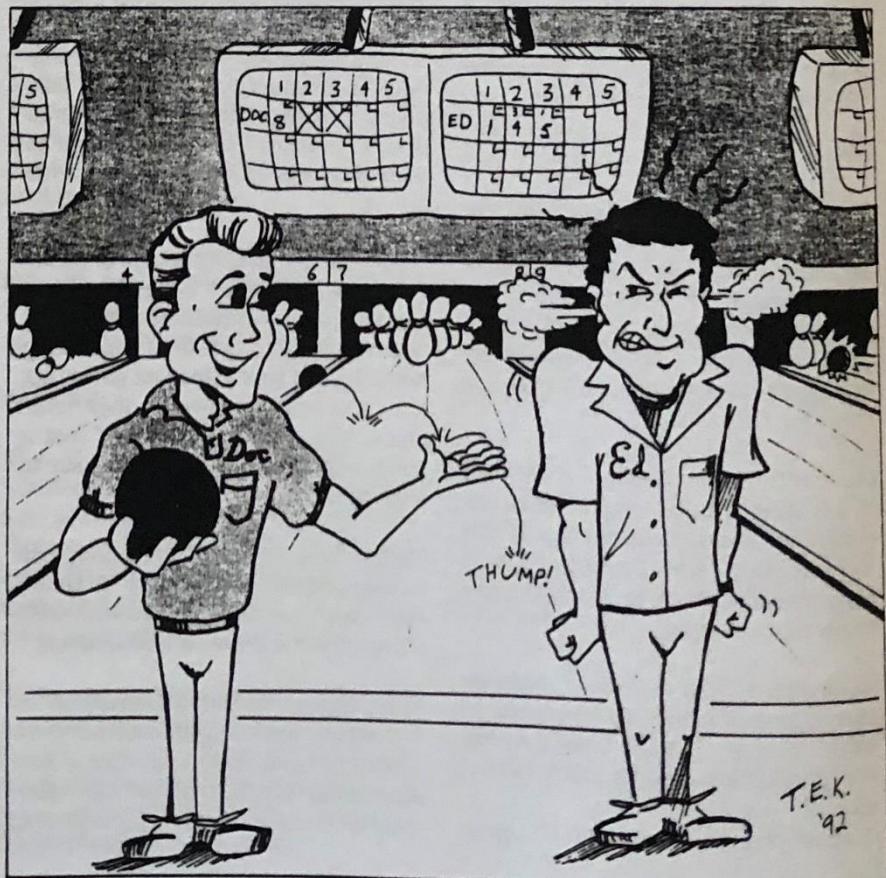
## 700 SERIES FOR SHEILA WHITE
