TEBRY SAUNDERS HITS 300:

S.E.B.A. Member TERRY SAUNDERS bowling with his team the SILVER ROLLERS in the Stamford Hill Supreme League on 5th. February achieved every bowlers dream when he strung together 12 strikes in his last game to record the first sanctioned 300 game ever bowled in a five person team enywhere in Europe. He also holds the European Record for the highest series ever bowled without a 200 game! Terry made a 686 set on games of 192-194-300. He earns a Gold and Diamond Watch from the B.T.B.A., another specially inscribed Gold Watch from A.M.F. for using one of their bowling balls, a new ACE Bowling Ball from Amerace Ltd and last but not least a cheque for £100 from the Tenpin Bowling Proprietors Association of Great Britain.

Terry, a big likeable fellow, is a left hander who throws a fairly full spinning hook ball and on this particular night he had it lined up well and truly in the strike pocket. With one exception the whole of the Supreme League stopped bowling to crowd at the back of the lane to see the last ball. The one sensible one who managed to dispel some of Terry's obvious last ball nerves was Bill Bridge of the Nomads who carried on bowling while Terry was weiting for his ball to return after the eleventh strike. Bills strategy worked as the twelth ball sailed into the pocket and practically the whole league jumped on him! A great moment for a very nice fellow. Well done Terry!

The 2nd. Annual B.T.B.A. Inter Counties Championships are being held again this year in Coventry on 17/18th. October with the qualifying rounds for Essex and Kent provisionally set for May 1st, June 28th, July 26th and August 23rd. Last year the Essex Men's Team and the Kent Ladies side both made the finals and in 1970 both counties hope to do even better.

Essex are holding an eight game preliminary qualifying round at the ABC Princess Bowl, Dagenham on 21/22nd February when 8 men and 10 ladies will be selected to play the same number of games each in the qualifying rounds. Should either team qualify the players with the highest averages over the games played will represent Essex in the finals. Essex Selection Committee have the right, under the Team Constitution to nominate one player per team if, in their opinion, such a player has had a year of outstanding success in the bowling The result of the trials will be published field. in the March issue of Bowling News with, it is

hoped, the names of those who have qualified to play for their County. Kent are using a different format

for selection purposes and all contenders will play a total of 12 games - 3 at each of the Kent centres. The remaining dates are Cliftonville on 8th. March, Whitstable on 22nd. March and Chatham on 3rd. May. The first round was played at Bexleyheath last Sunday and Buzz Morrison of Bexleyheath and Mike Luckhurst of Whitstable lead after this first stage with fine series of 641 and 602 respectively. 

The trios division is nothing short of ridiculous. Your team could average well over 200 per game and not come anywhere the top three placings in damage and particular congratulations here to both the WEMBLEY ALL STARS and both NOMADS teams.

Men's doubles was not a particular forte of the area until such time as the SATURDAY PAIRS TOURNAMENT came into being — now look at the lists! A high series of 1287 and no doubt the 1300 not very far away as the 500 game has already been seen. FRED SHRIMPTON on 265 and TEDDY TINLING with 236 were the pair who did the trick. In the Mixed Doubles no team has yet topped the 1204 series from VICKY & BERT TIMMS of last season but the game record went for the proverbial burton when JOYCE & LEE JORDAN in the Bexleyheath HITS & MISSES LEAGUE hit a mighty 477 late last year. A few nights ago BILL BRIDGE bowled games of 230-210-255 for a personal best series of 695. A very fine performance that anyone would be proud of — but it dosn't even get a mention in the listings! Three 700's top the chart and sitting on top, of course, is that magnificent 745 of MIKE COPE which included one of the two: 299 games bowled already this season. MICK BURRIDGE, already the author of an unsantioned 300 game, shares top spot here also with a 299.

Only a few years ago the men's division would have looked quite good with a high series and game of 642 and 268 - these are now the standards to beat for the Ladies! Even our youngsters take some beating with young GRAHAM RALPH from Chatham holding top spot on 638 shot at Bexleyheath in the Saturday Pairs and JEFF DAVIS with all three high games including the record to beat in this division of 253.
