

### **Detroit Team Tops Scores** With 1160 Game, 3230 Series

Detroit, Mich., traditionally the largest woman's bowling association in WIBC membership, jumped off to that same position in team scores in November.

The Holiday Magic team, captained by Anita Cantaline, rolled games of 992, 1078 and 1160 for a 3230 series in the

Detroit Ladies' Major League at Pine Tree Bowl.

The 1160 and 3230 are season highs in WIBC play for five-woman teams. The 3230 ranks as the fifth-highest team series on record for WIBC members and the 1160 is the eighth-highest game ever bowled.

Both are new records for Detroit WBA members, topping the previous highs of 1141 and 3169.

WIBC records are 3379 by Freeway Washer & Stamping

Co. of Cleveland, Ohio, during 1959-60 and 1193 by Pitch's Lounge of Milwaukee, Wis., during 1964-65.
"We had 17 open frames," sighed Anita, "or we might have gone by those all-time national records." The 17 opens included 10 misses and seven splits.

Four of the five members rolled 600 series, topped by Doris O'Brinski's 679. Other series were: Miss Cantaline, 638; Elvira Toepfer, 654; Doris Krause, 668; and Carol Schemers, 591.
