A fine 90 team entry ensured the success of the 2nd Annual Dagenham December Doubles and with a total prize fund of £180.00 the competition was fierce throughout the whole of the two day event.

The early leaders were a mixed doubles pairing from Slough, CAROLE COLLIER & PETER CUTHBERT, who bowled 1630 scratch over the 4 games giving them a handicap total of 1730. Throughout the rest of Saturday and for all of the Sunday squads teams strove to top these totals and a number came very near the mark, in particular the Richmond Grille pairing of MIKE PARKER & PHIL BOYCE with 1623 and the two Brunswick Jet duos of DAVE LEWIS & JAN ROZE and BILL LIGHT & BRIAN WILKINS with 1606 and 1603 respectively. The Wembley All Stars couldn't strike their usual Dagenham form and only COLIN PRESLAND really played well for his side's 1600 total. The Nomads fared no better and neither did The Committee. When these two teams joined forces for the final squad, however, things looked very much brighter as the respective representatives WILL CLARKE & TERRY SAUNDERS immediately opened with a 400 game and followed it with 450, 375 and 414 to total 1639 scratch, 1735 with handicap. Will Clarke, in fact, had the high 4-game series of the tournament with 885 closely followed by JAN ROZE 883, COLIN PRESLAND 866, MIKE PARKER 860, BRIAN WILKINS & TOM OWEN 855, TONY CANTOR 854, CAROLE COLLIER 830, BRIAN NEWSON 825, ALAN CHAPMAN 812, 16 years old COLIN PEPLER 811, BILL LIGHT 810, FRED WARREN 806, COLIN CROWTHER 801, RON HORNSEY & PETER CUTHBERT 800 and from earlier entries COLIN PRESLAND 811 and WILL CLARKE 810. A grand total of 18 bowlers all averaging over 200!

# Kessex Open Trios 4th ANNUAL

Although no fewer than three other tournaments in the London area alone clashed with the 4th. Annual Kessex Open Trios the event managed to muster 42 handicap entries and 25 scratch ones for a satisfactory total entry of 67 giving a total prize fund of over £170.00. Scoring throughout was steady with the WEMBLEY ALL STARS eventually taking the scratch title on 1760 closely chased by the ORPHEIANS II with 1735. Consolation for the Whitstable side (£50.00 worth of consolation in fact!) was their handicap total of 1936 that just topped the score of 1934 from the Crawley based TROUBLESHOOTERS team that had stood since the first squad on the Saturday.

High game and series of the event went to TED CULLEN with 258 and 654 and he was followed by MALCOLM GLOVER 635, ALAN WILKINSON 624, BILLY PRESTON 622, COLIN PRESLAND 609 and WILL CLARKE 603.
