MEGNIFICENT !!

Great Britain gold medallist Meg Coombes from Tyneside is very well known by bowlers everywhere but SEBA member MEG SHAW from Southend was a name unknown to many until the BTBA Masters Invitational Championships were held last week-and at Tolworth. In fact it was immediately obvious that there could not be two such pleasant and attractive high kickers and that Meg Coombes and Meg Shaw were one and the same! Her move from North to South and change of name had taken nothing from her ability as she proceeded to demonstrate by averaging 203 over her six games and taking the 1972 title on sets of 560 and 657. In runners-up position came a new name to the National scene. Another Geordie, but bowling at the little Scottish centre at R.A.F. Leuchers, MARGARET TODD looked like having everything her own way when opening with a 651 but she could not maintain her striking form and her second series of 526 gave her 1177. Third spot went to LILY THOMPSON from Belle Vue with 1153, just two pins in front of CAROLE CUTHBERT. The composite average of all the girls over their 216 games was just under 179 - good bowling by any standards.

In the Men's division it was CHRIS BUCK who was the favourite for this year's title and it soon became apparent why! Opening with a 628 he stormed on to a 694 and 625 for an incredible nine game average of 216 and an invincible total of 1947. MO KNAPP of the Richmond Grille team from Southampton came in second on 1841 with SEBA member BRIAN WILKINS, with 1825, just pipping Manchester's NORMAN HIGGINBOTTOM for third spot by two pins by finishing with a 245 game.

Another SEBA member, PETE BOYD of Bexleyheath, covered himself with glory when hitting 11 strikes in a row in the doubles event and finishing with an eight count for a new Nationals high game record of 298. Treestoppers PAUL MAYOR and ALAN WEALL topped both doubles divisions where, in the handicap section, SEBA had a grand slam with NIGEL HOLGATE and JERRY MOLL of the Ski-Bolts taking second spot jointly with MAC MCCARTNEY and PETE BOYD. For the ladies it was again JANET MORRISON who shone and over her nine all-events games she averaged 192 and came second in the all-events table from Margaret Little and third in doubles with WYN COLLISON. MARY SABAN and DOLLY HART just missed the handicap doubles title by 4 pins and the GEMS team were knocked into 3rd spot by just 1 pin. Other members to get into the placings were VICKY TIMMS in the handicap singles, ALAN WEALL, BRIAN WILKINS and JERRY MOLL in the All Events, PHIL RUSSELL in the Singles and TREETOP and both the CLIFTONVILLE & WEMBLEY ALL STARS in the team event.

As always the organisation throughout was excellent.
