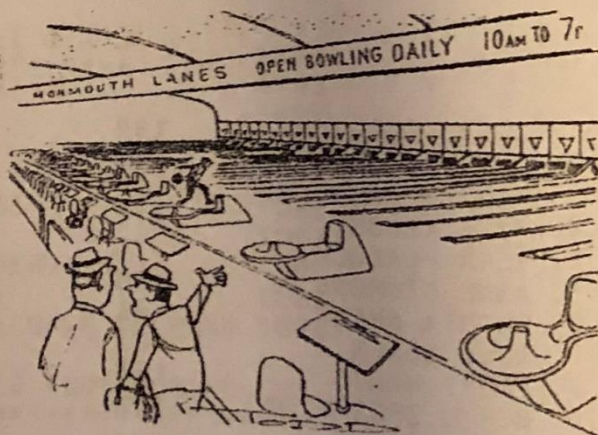

INTER — CENTRE CHAMP'S!

The brain child of Basildon Executive Officer John Buckley, the S.E.B.A. Inter-Centre Championships have now been formulated and the draw for the first venue was made during the A.G.M. at Dagenham where the first name out of the hat was Cliftonville with Dagenham as the reserve venue. The championships take in all standards of bowler at each centre and to make an even number of teams for each event Walton Pier Bowl have been invited to take part.

The centres participating should, therefore, look like this:-

BASILDON
BEXLEYHEATH
CLIFTONVILLE
DAGENHAM
HARLOW
SOUTHEND
WALTON PIER
WHITSTABLE

The inclusive charge per centre will be £18.00, i.e. £1.00 per player but it is anticipated that fund raising within each bowl will allow those selected to play without personal cost.

Each centre will produce competitors for each of seven events which have been agreed as follows:-

5-Person Team

May consist of men, women or juniors BUT current seasons average for each player must not exceed 159, 169, 179, 189, 199 for the five participants, thus giving a team fairly representative of the standards within each bowl.

4-Person Junior Team

Any four juniors from the centre may participate but only one is allowed to be 16 years old or over. Team may be made up of boys or girls or both.

3-Person Team - Ladies

Regardless of average three women bowlers will compete in this event.

2-Person Team - Men

Again no qualification upon average - open to men of all standards.

Mixed Doubles

This pairing must be an existing league team from the centre that they represent and must have played a minimum of 21 games in league in order to qualify.

Men's Singles

Open to all male bowlers within the centre.

Ladies Singles

Open to all lady bowlers within the centre.

Scratch pinfall will decide each event with points being awarded to the placings on the following basis:-

Maximum points that any one centre could win would be 70 and the centre with the highest overall points total will be declared champions.	1st	10 points

Final date to be decided but possibly Sunday, 1st. October.

Should two centres tie on points after all seven events have been rolled the five person team, which event completes the championships, will play one further game against the team from the other centre to break the tie. Selection of teams will be left to the centre representatives and managers to decide upon the format that best suits each individual case.

AREA BADGES

Although there is now a National Badge Award scheme operated through B.T.B.A. there are still quite a number of S.E.B.A. badges left in stock. These are available to members while the stocks last and the old Badge Application Award Form should be utilised and forwarded to JOHN SAWYER in the usual way. To aid Area finances it has been suggested that a nominal charge per badge of 15p be made but this will not be put into force until 1st. May 1972. If you have rolled a score that merits a badge get the form in early if you want to avoid the charge!
