POINTS OF IMPORTANCE FOR LEAGUE OFFICERS AND ALL LEAGUE BOWLERS - READ AND DIGEST AND ENSURE THAT YOUR LEAGUE HAS A TROUBLE FREE SEASON 1972/1973 !!!

1. LEAGUES SANCTIONED FOR SEASON 1971/1972 HAVE ALREADY RECEIVED BTBA FORM NO. LK102. COMPLETE IT INCLUDING YOUR LEAGUES STARTING AND FINISHING NO. LK102. COMPLETE IT OF BANK HOLIDAYS ETC. AND RETURN IT TO BRIAN DATES (REMEMBER TO ALLOW FOR BANK HOLIDAYS ETC.) AND RETURN IT TO BRIAN LANGFORD WHEN YOUR PRE-SEASON EQUIPMENT TO COVER YOU FOR 6 WEEKS WILL BE

ISSUED BY RETURN.

2. AS SOON AS YOU HAVE OBTAINED THE MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION CARDS BACK FROM ALL YOUR LEAGUE MEMBERS SEND THEM TOGETHER WITH MEMBERSHIP DUES (DAGENHAM ALL YOUR LEAGUE MEMBERS SEND THEM TOGETHER WITH MEMBERSHIP DUES (DAGENHAM BEXLEYHEATH & CLIFTONVILLE DNLY) AND THE SANCTION APPLICATION FORM DULY COMPLETED TO BRIAN LANGFORD. YOUR FULL SEASON'S LEAGUE KIT WILL THEN BE ISSUED. YOUR LEAGUE IS COVERED FOR SANCTION FOR 42 DAYS ONLY. ENSURE THAT THE FORM, CARDS AND DUES IF APPLICABLE ARE SENT OFF WITHIN THIS TIME FOR SANCTIONING TO CONTINUE FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE SEASON.

3. MEMBERSHIP DUES ARE 10p PER BOWLER BUT THIS CHARGE IS PAID FOR YOU AT BASILDON, HARLOW, SOUTHEND & WHITSTABLE BY THE PROPRIETOR. PAY 10p IF YOU JOIN AT BEXLEYHEATH, CLIFTONVILLE OR DAGENHAM.

4. MEMBERSHIP CARD APPLICATIONS AND DUES IF APPROPRIATE FOR NEW MEMBERS OF YOUR LEAGUE WHO JOIN AFTER YOUR LEAGUE IS SANCTIONED SHOULD BE SENT TO BRIAN LANGFORD WITH THE BTBA FORM LK103. IF IN DOUBT SEE YOUR BOWL REP.

5. YOUR AREA ASSOCIATION IS ARRANGING FOR A SPECIAL MEETING WITH ALL LEAGUE OFFICERS AT YOUR CENTRE. MAKE SURE YOUR LEAGUE IS REPRESENTED WHEN THE DATE IS FIXED.

6. ENSURE THAT YOUR LEAGUE HAS IT'S DWN CONSTITUTION VOTED UPON BY THE MEMBERS PRIOR TO THE NEW SEASON. LEAGUE OFFICERS DO NOT MAKE THEIR OWN DECISIONS UPON HANDICAPS, BLIND SCORES, POSTPONEMENTS ETC OFF THEIR OWN BAT. A MAJORITY VOTE OF ALL THE LEAGUE DECIDED THESE AND LIKE ISSUES PRIOR TO THE SEASON COMMENCING. USE THE SUGGESTED LEAGUE RULES IN YOUR BTBA RULE BOOK. REFER ANY DOUBTS OR PROBLEMS TO YOUR BOWL REPRESENTATIVE OR TO BRIAN LANGFORD.

7. ENSURE THAT YOUR LEAGUE ELECTS A COMMITTEE AT THE START OF THE SEASON TO DECIDE A SUGGESTED PRIZE LIST. THIS SHOULD BE AGREED UPON BY ALL THE LEAGUE AND PUBLISHED WITHIN 5 WEEKS OF THE SEASON COMMENCING. THERE CAN BE NO ARGUAMENTS AT THE END OF THE SEASON IF EVERYTHING IS AGREED BEFORE ANYONE IS AWARE OF WHO THE WINNERS ARE GOING TO BE.

B. ENSURE THAT YOUR ELECTED LEAGUE TREASURER OPENS A BANK ACCOUNT FOR YOUR LEAGUE IN THE NAME OF THE LEAGUE. THAT A MINIMUM OF TWO SIGNATURES ARE NECESSARY FOR ANY MONIES TO BE WITHDRAWN. THAT THE BANK STATEMENTS ARE SENT OUT MONTHLY TO THE LEAGUE PRESIDENT WHO CAN AGREE THEM AND HAND THEM TO THE TREASURER AFTER INDICATING ON THE SPACE PROVIDED ON THE LEAGUE STANDING SHEET HOW MUCH YOUR LEAGUE HAS IN IT'S ACCOUNT ON A MONTHLY BASIS. PROVIDING THESE POINTS ARE COMPLIED WITH YOUR LEAGUE

FUNDS ARE COVERED BY THE FREE BTBA INSURANCE SCHEME.

9. CHECK THE BTBA CARD OF ANYONE WHO JOINS THE LEAGUE AFTER IT'S START AND STATES THAT THEY ARE ALREADY A MEMBER. HIGH SCORE RECOGNITION COULD BE WITHELD IF A MEMBER OF THE ASSOCIATION IS, EVEN UNWITTINGLY, PLAYING WITH OR AGAINST A NOW MEMBER!

WITH OR AGAINST A NON MEMBER!

10. BOWLING NEWS MAGAZINE IS ISSUED FREE OF CHARGE TO ALL TEAM CAPTAINS IN ALL SANCTIONED LEAGUES. ADVISE BRIAN LANGFORD OF ANYTHING THAT IS NEWSWORTHY WITHIN YOUR LEAGUE AND TO ENSURE THAT THIS IS DONE ELECT A PRESS OFFICER.

PROVIDING YOUR LEAGUE COMPLIES WITH ALL THESE QUITE SIMPLE POINTS IT CAN BE ALMOST GUARANTEED THAT YOU WILL HAVE AN ENJOYABLE AND TROUBLEFREE SEASON !!
