On The League Front

On The League Front

As is stated on our front page, IT'S ALL HAPPENING! Whilst the season had a slow start as far as scores were concerned things have now perked up with a vengeance. At Basildon the ENVEMEN KNIGHTS in the Shell Trios League bowled the second highest trios game ever in the Area when BARRY MAUGHAN, BARRY GREENLAND & KEITH PAIN combined with respective games of 246, 218 and 268 for a great 732 total. Their 1845 series total for the night, however, doesn't even get in the top three of the Area Hi's! The Nomads held the Bexleyheath house record for trios series with an 1861. THE COMMITTEE bowling in the Remington Trios are now the new holders with an 1894. The score sheet looked like this:-

An event of an entirely different kind occurred to BILLY PRESTON in the Supreme when he struck 8 times in one game for a grand total of 147!! Billy struck every time on one lane and opened every time on the other. Is this some sort of unenviable record?

An addition to the season's 700 tally and a 'first' for RICHARD POTTS. Rolling for the Rebels in the Dagenham Masters end of league event Dick tallied 242-267-224 for a fine 733 set, the season's highest to date.

Also from Dagenham a bowler who doesn't normally make the headlines, TINA BEST of the Flintstone Mixed Doubles, fired a personal best game of 245 which now lies joint second in the current rankings.

A very much 'in form' bowler who looks likely to make his first 700 any day is CHRIS SMITH. He just missed out recently, in fact, in totalling a fine 697 on games of 225-259-213. The MARGAMATICS third place ranking of 660 in the trios games was mainly due to a fine 279 game from Area Vice President TOM BALLINGALL backed by JACK WILKINSON and DAVE DRUCE. The second placing in this section comes from the Basildon Atlas League where the JOKERS team of KEITH PAIN, DEREK WATERMAN and RON SAPSFORD had respective games of 211, 188 and 269 for a total of 668.

From Whitstable the HELMSMEN took the 4-person team series with a 2241 only to lose it a few days later when the SOUTHEND APACHES topped it with a 2256. The Apaches also come into second position in the team games with a 788 but the Bexleyheath BARBARIANS still hang on to top spot with their 815 bowled last year.

A report is to hand of a fine 260 game from young 14 years old DAVE RACE which with games of 166 and 191 gave him a 617 series. Nothing yet to hand as far as the Area Hi's go however.

The Cliftonville Petersen Doubles League continues it's high scoring ways and with the first round of 19 weeks now complete and with a prize fund of over £400 the battles still go on without let up. Out in front by a margin of 108 pins are FOUNDATION I followed by PLAYBOYS RED and MARGAMATICS 2 third. Two new league and house records have been set up with COLIN PEPLER firing a 662 and the FOUNDATION I duo of TED CULLEN and CHRIS SMITH firing 632 and 625 respectively for a 1257. Individual averages in the league are among the highest ever in the centre with 8 bowlers on 180 plus and another 14 over 170. Current high average is CHRIS SMITH with 187 over 60 with the ladies more than holding their end up with ANNE SIMMONS on 177 over the same number of games and DOREEN CULLEN holding a 175 over 54.

A new sponsored league has commenced at Dagenham where the BOOTH'S GIN CLASSIC DOUBLES takes to the lanes following the Thursday Supreme. Secretary of both leagues is DAVE COHEN who reports an excellent start with averages in the 190's and already a 1271 series to beat from the TREETOP pairing of KEITH PORTER and ALAN WEALL. Worth a third place in the back page listings.

ERIC KEEN, secretary of the Cliftonville Mr and Mrs League took his bowlers to Edgware for a return challenge match and, although they lost, everyone had a good time with EILEEN JORDAN finding the Edgware lanes to her liking for a 201 game and husband DEL JORDAN holding his end up with a 229. In the league itself it is the ladies who are rolling all the high scores at the moment with SHIELA ROGERS, MURIEL PHILLIPS and PHYL KEEN all improving their averages quite considerably with respective series of 553, 563 and 548.

COLIN ROWLAND has proved a very efficient secretary for the Southend Lobster League and we would like to take this opportunity of wishing him well for his forthcoming marriage in September. The league is now to be run by PETER VALENTINE.
