PAUL CRUNDELL 637, JOHN ELDER 631 and GEORGE NELSON 579 totalled a fine 1847 only to have to watch PHIL RUSSELL of the ALL STARS on his best form string strikes for a great 696 and backed by BOBBY MANSFIELD 613 and BERNIE WHITE 573 total the winning score of 1882. Cliftonvilles JILL GRIMES rolled a fine 632 series and young NICKY HARRIS, a junior from Southend, helped her team the PINK PANTHERS to a placing with a 483 set. # EURO - CHAMPS

Following last year's A.G.M. of the B.T.B.A. JOHN REV disputed the validity of the Chair and some Officers of the Association and, being a man of considerable means, backed up his assertions with the issuance of a High Court Writ. After a considerable amount of negotiation between the solicitors acting for both parties and between the parties themselves the issues, which were basically technical ones, were resolved without the necessity of the case actually coming before High Court - at a cost of something like £5,000 a day! - and B.T.B.A. could recommence work again with John Rev now with them instead of against them. Sometimes it takes a war to bring about a lasting peace and the problems of this season to date, although frustrating in many ways, will now mean a stronger and legally approved Constitution and probably the last of any further internal problems. In fact John Rev, with his wealth of experience on the Continent with the old Harry Stiller Racers team, has been given the task of selecting and training men's teams to represent Great Britain both in next months European Championships in Dublin and for the 1975 World Championships scheduled for this country for the first time.

Following a number of trials up and down the country the following team has been produced and our best wishes go with them to Ireland together with the ladies who have been selected by their own committee. Congratulations to S.E.B.A. members JANET MORRISON, MEG SHAW and PAUL SCOTTOW, all of whom will be wearing GREAT BRITAIN shirts for the week in Dublin from 9th - 15th. September this year. # DAG DOUBLES

The Dagenham Classic Doubles was a new tournament for the Dagenham calendar and, attracting 48 entries over 6 games each, will now become an annual event. The tournament was classified in both male and female divisions but once again our lady bowlers failed to support an event that was specifically designed for them not to have to compete against men. In fact only five ladies teams entered the scratch section and only two in the handicap, and one of those came from R.A.F. Lakenheath!

PAULINE BOWRY and JANE VIROT from Tolworth set up a 2127 score that began to look a mere formality to beat when Bexleyheath's JANET MORRISON and WYN COLLISON took to the lanes. In fact it was all over with just five frames of the sixth game to go when Janet took a large piece of skin out of her thumb and opening her last four frames the pair missed out by just 9 unlucky pins.

The mens divisions looked much more like a tournament with 41 entries and it was the Lewisham pairing of WILL WATTS and DEL GROOM who won the handicap top prize with a pinfall to include handicap of 2392. Groom carries only a 146 average but obviously found the Dagenham lanes to his liking shooting a scratch total well above his entering standard with individual games to include a 200 and a 193. Partner Watts with a 167 average made a scratch 625 over his final 3 games which assured them of the top placing over Dagenham's BILL BRIDGE and ERIC BAKER who opened with series of 626 and 603 respectively but cooled a little in the second set to finish with 2327.

In the scratch section CHRIS SMITH and GEORGE NELSON bowled very well all day and thoroughly deserved the tournament's major prize. Full results were as follows:-
