The paper crisis coupled with price halted regular production and then, when the situation had eased, the National Championships and Masters, the Area Annual General Meeting followed by an Extraordinary General Meeting, other meetings at Cliftonville and Southend, the Area Championships and our own Masters meant that there were not enough days in the week to keep up regular issue at that stage. As the weeks went by more and more news was collected until, in the end, this very late but bumper edition just had to be written up and printed. A quite mammoth task and one that, it is hoped, won't have to be repeated, for having now got reasonably up to date our intention is to once again resume a regular publication. The 1p per series bowled in league and tournament within the Association now being paid into Area funds means that the finances for this and other things will again be available and the position of SEBA generally is looking healthier than at any time in the past three years. Only time still remains a problem.

What has happened in the World of bowling since February that has to be reported. Inside there are details of the National and Area Championships and Masters plus the important meetings mentioned above, the SEBA Inter-Centre Championships, John Player Inter-County Cup, BTBA Inter-County Championships qualifying rounds for Essex and Kent and a new format for the event as a whole, the Women's National Committee's first and highly successful tournament, four 700's from Area members plus the first 700 in Europe from a lady, the European Junior Championships, England vs Scotland, Norma Bridge Memorial Trophy, Falling Leaf, Harp Lager, Thameside Trios, 600 Club, 200 Club and 550 Club Championships plus the latest from the threatened centres at Basildon and Bexleyheath. # 13th ANNUAL B.T.B.A. NATIONAL TENPIN BOWLING CHAMPIONSHIPS

The BTBA 13th. Annual Championships were held this year at the Ambassador Lanes, Hounslow and whilst space precludes a full results listing in all 16 events the new champions and a resume of each event were as follows:-

## REGULAR TEAM

THE CHESSMEN from Bexleyheath came third for £75.00 with a 2719 actual giving them 3065 with handicap added. The ITSSA POST OFFICE from Hounslow topped the handicap with 3196 with JARDINES from Aylesbury second on 3067 for £200.00 and £100.00 respectively. In the scratch section the first prize of £100.00 went to MALLORY INTERNATIONAL with 2890 followed by the SCOTTISH TEAM 2794 and the SCEPTRES 2792.

## REGULAR DOUBLES

A real SEBA bonanza here with JOE ARTNER and JAKE JACOBSON from Dagenham taking the major prize of £200.00 with 1177 actual, 1333 handicap from EDDIE LINAS and DOUG VAUGHAN from Ipswich who just topped BILL MCILVEEN and DANNY PENNEY of Dagenham by three pins - 1318 to 1315 - for runner-up spot and the difference between a second place £100.00 and a third place £50.00. PHIL RUSSEL and BOBBY MANSFIELD were second in scratch with 1208 to the winning total of 1265 from TOMMY MARSHALL and GEOFF BUCK of the Airport Bowl but still good for £50.00 and the other two All Stars teams of BERNIE WHITE and BOB BLABER and RAY HOOK and DAVE MABERLEY also cashed. The first time all three doubles from one team entry have all figured in the prize money of the Nationals.

## REGULAR SINGLES

Top placing from SEBA was Bexleyheath's BERNIE FISHER with 581 actual, 681 handicap who finished 4th for £15.00. Top placing was 170 average S. MILLER from Aylesbury who fired a fine scratch 677 for an unbeatable 757 with handicap added. Other Area members who appeared in the prize monies were RON CARPENTER (Dagenham) 611+68, BERNIE WHITE (Dagenham) 639 + 34, JOHN STRETTLE (Dagenham) 594 + 74, MALCOLM GLOVER (Dagenham) 566 + 80 and PHIL RUSSELL (Dagenham) 605 + 40. In the scratch division BERNIE WHITE was the Area high with 639 for 5th position.

## REGULAR ALL EVENTS

Dagenham's JOE ARTNER was runner-up here to Aylesbury's S. MILLER and won £50.00 for a fine total of 1989. BOBBY MANSFIELD was 4th for £15.00 and JOHN AMOS (Bexleyheath) and BERNIE FISHER (Bexleyheath) were also placed. Scratch was topped by TOMMY MARSHALL with 1862 and here BOBBY MANSFIELD was third with 1837, JOE ARTNER with 1791 was seventh and PHIL RUSSELL 15th on 1734.

## LADIES TEAM

THE ROYALS from Tolworth, THE DOMINOES of Harrow, The PINDDOWNS of Corby and the JARDINES JEYS from Aylesbury were the only teams to place with the Tolworth taking premier position in handicap and the Corby team topping the scratch.

## LADIES DOUBLES

Area Bowlers again did well in the doubles with MEG SHAW (Southend) winning both scratch and handicap titles with her Co. Durham partner ENA PRATTLEY and KATH HARVEY and PEARL LEHRIAN (Basildon) third and PEGGY HAMMOND and POPPY HOWIS (Bexleyheath) 7th and all making the prize listings.

## LADIES SINGLES

No joy at all for SEBA here with PAULINE THOMPSON from Belle Vue firing a 606 to take the scratch title and adding 94 pins handicap to also land the handicap.

## LADIES ALL EVENTS

Again nothing for SEBA. ANGIE HIGGINBOTTOM (Belle Vue) took the handicap with Scotland's MARGARET TODD, with 1681 top of the scratch section. Total Prize Fund for the Tournament was £3151.00



# AREA CHAMPIONSHIPS

SEBA's 12th. Annual Championships keep their reputation as the largest Area Championships anywhere in the country. Although team entries were slightly down on the usual the doubles and singles more than made up any slight deficiency in the overall number of games bowled. Winning scores were high, the Bexleyheath Member of Parliament, the Rt. Hon. CYRIL TOWNSEND, M.P., opened the proceedings, a fine exhibition of all that is best in the game was given by World Cup Champion BERNIE CATERER and to round things off Joe Bowler had to be renamed Josephine Bowler when a red faced JANET MORRISON came out of the hat to roll the opening ball garbed in the traditional cloak and crown.
