County Championships ESSEX & KENT

The 1974 BTBA Inter-County Championships has an entirely changed format for the qualifying rounds and, for the first time, both ESSEX and KENT find themselves in the same group. With them are Suffolk, Surrey, Sussex, Middlesex and London. The top two from the group qualify for the finals and the winners and runners-up here will have really earned a place! This year there are only two rounds instead of the usual four and at each round each county plays an 8 game round robin, one game against each county and one bye with 2 points for each game won and one point for a draw. The highest losing qualifier over the four groups also goes through together with Scotland to make a 10 team final as before. Round 1 is at the Airport Bowl on June 23rd and a full report of how the SEBA teams fared will be in the next issue. Round 2 is at the Mecca Bowl at STREATHAM on August 18th. Both Essex and Kent have completed their trials and the names of the teams and reserves will be published also next month.

EURO - CHAMPS

Full details are not to hand but congratulations to the GREAT BRITAIN team in the European Junior Championships held in Holland who came home with the Gold Medals in the 5-man team event and in the Individual All Events where CHAS MCCARTHY from Harrow was triumphant. SEBA member and Prospect of the Year PELER CHOUHAN was a member of the 5-man team together with newest All Star SYD SYMONDS, KIM DIXON and KIM JOHNSON (Brize Norton) and MARK WILLS (Plymouth).

The ABC Bowl, Dagenham was this year host to the annual 600 Club, 200 Club and 550 Club member's tournaments. As befits a centre that boasts more 700 series on it's lanes than any other in Europe, the 600 Club event was won with a 700 series! With a steady 190 opener ALAN NORRIS commenced to string strikes and went out with a 235 and a 279 for a fine 704 and the Club Championships for 1973. On games of 213-198-245 for a 656 PETER COOTE was runner-up with MALCOLM GLOVER making third on a 590.

A SECRETARY'S RESPONSIBILITY

A number of applications are being received for completely new supplies of league materials for leagues who are extending their bowling schedule through the Summer but appear to regarding themselves as new leagues. All league secretaries should note that the present league record card is specifically designed to cover 52 weeks and the only new cards that should be required are for new teams or members. The only fresh materials that should be needed over and above that supplied at the beginning of the Winter league are standing sheets and membership application cards and in both these respects your respective Bowl Representative should be able to assist as stocks are carried at each centre for the most part.

When extending for a Summer season please use the that is included with all initial league kits. Send both copies of the pink form to Brian Langford and ensure that the opening and closing dates of the league are indicated together with and changes in the league officers. Do not forget to include a copy of your final standing sheet together with the prize fund allocation when sending the LK104 as without these documents the League Champions Badges and Achievement Badge cannot be issued. These are normally available from August of each year. Should additional sets be needed for the Summer league these can be purchased direct from BTBA at a charge of 20p per badge.
