SOUTHEND SPECTACULAR!

2,274 games were rolled to decide the 13th Annual S.E.B.A. Championships at Southend and the prize fund produced of over £600.00 was an alltime Championship record. The tournament was the third largest ever in the Area's history and had Basildon been open to receive the entry forms and had the promised entry from Walton materialised the record would have been topped quite easily. With Basildon re-opening in June, however, and with a representative entry from Walton we are sure that the 14th Championships scheduled for Whitstable in 1976 will be the biggest ever.

Overall scoring at Southend was excellent with no less than six new Championships records being created and JOHN BOOTH and STEVE CHAPMAN and all their centre staff are to be congratulated on the first class manner in which everything was undertaken.

COLIN PRESLAND was personally responsible for four of the new records and was involved in the fifth. His scratch average for the nine games in singles, doubles and team was a remarkable 215.44 - fine bowling by any standards.

Young Southend Junior DAVE RACE became the first ever junior to record a 700 within S.E.B.A. when in the Doubles event he hit games of 255-250-202 for a 707 total, the second highest sanctioned series by a junior ever in this country. The following weekend he competed in the NAYBC National Championships at Leeds and came home with a medal for the singles. A very nice week's work.

Bexleyheath's VERA ROPER took both singles titles with a scratch 590 giving her 686 with handicap added and KEITH PAIN and ALAN SAMUELS added their names to the doubles trophy with 1227 actual, 1335 handicap. The closest finish was in the handicap team regular division where ALPHA OMEGA added to their National's success with a first place on 3172 just 2 pins in front of SOUTHEND 1 who, inturn, were 2 pins in front of TREETOP who, nevertheless, had ample compensation with the scratch title totalling 2934, a new Championship record.

The 4th Annual SEBA Masters Championships were very successful with JANET MORRISON winning the trophy outright with her third win in a row and RAY HOOK adding his name to the illustrious ones already on it.

Another 'record' worthy of note was a score of 281. For three games! The bowler, who shall be anonymous, was said to have walked to the end of Southend Pier after his set with the intention of throwing his ball into the sea. Unfortunately he missed!!

OUR MASTERS

The 4th Annual S.E.B.A. Masters was a very successful event and turned in close finishes in both ladies and men's divisions. Rolling over five games this year JANET MORRISON was looking for a third straight victory but with only a 509 total over the first three games compared with 563 from POPPY HOWIS and 542 from PAT OVERY her chances looked slim. Even a fourth game of 204 left her still lagging but a final strike spree for a 244 clinched the title.

After three games in the men's section KEITH PAIN led the field on 620 closely followed by RAY HOOK with 615. MICK BURRIDGE, ALAN WEALL, DAVE LEHRIAN, COLIN PRESLAND, ROGER BRIGHT, KEITH PORTER and DAVE MABERLEY were all still in contention and after the fourth game only three pins separated the leaders. INTER - CENTRE ' 75

All centres within S.E.B.A. should now be thinking seriously about team selection and fund raising for the 3rd. Annual INTER-CENTRE CHAMPIONSHIPS now fixed for Sunday 13th. July at the newly re-opened BASILDON BOWL. Entry Forms will soon be out and, as a reminder, the following divisions are catered for. Each centre must consist of 18 players, each of whom will bowl one three game series in one of the events:-

1. 5-PERSON TEAM - To consist of men, women or junior bowlers but must contain 5 players whose highest current average from any league over a minimum of 21 games in the complete 1974/75 Season does not exceed 159, 169, 179, 189 and 199 respectively down the line.
2. 4-PERSON JUNIOR TEAM - Any four juniors from the centre may compete but only one is allowed to be 16 years of age or over as at the date of the tournament.
3. 3-PERSON TEAM - LADIES - Regardless of age or average three women from each centre will compete in this event.
4. MEN'S DOUBLES - No qualification upon age or average and open to men of all standards.
5. MIXED DOUBLES - This pairing must be a male and female bowler who play in the same team in the centre of entry regularly and who have bowled a minimum of 21 games together on this basis in the current season.
6. MEN'S SINGLES - Open to all male bowlers who compete in league in the centre of entry and who have bowled a minimum of 21 games in the current season on this basis.
7. LADIES SINGLES - Open to all women bowlers who compete in league in the centre of entry and who have bowled a minimum of 21 games in the centre on this basis.

Scratch pinfall will decide each event with points being awarded 10 to first place, 6 to second, 5 to third, 4 to fourth and so on down the line.

The inclusive entry fee per centre will be £22.50, i.e. £1.25 per entrant, but most centres will raise funds in this respect to avoid their representatives having any personal outlay.

Should two centres tie on points after all seven events have been completed the 5-Person Team, which event completes the Championships, will play one further game against the team from the other centre to break the tie. Selection of teams will be left to the Centre Representatives and interested Managers to decide the methods best suited to each individual bowl.
