At the final count it was Southend who took the 10 points for their first section win of the day and their team of HARRY ADELSTON, BILL STREET, STEVE VICTORY, FRANK YUILLE and PETER COOTE held off the Bexleyheath line-up of TED PINK, BUZZ MORRISON, TED SHRIMPTON, BILL BRIDGE and MAC MCCARTNEY by just 6 pins and they, in turn, were just 5 pins in front of Basildon who were represented by MALCOLM YULE, BILL TABENER, GARRY BATES, GEORGE KIMBER and BILL SHEAD. Had Basildon won with Bexleyheath second a play off in accordance with the rules would have been necessary and had Basildon won with Southend second they would have won the Inter-Centre Cup. All this means that after 270 games the 1975 event was, in fact, decided by just 11 pins. You can't get a much closer result than that! The venue for 1976 will be between Southend, Dagenham, Whitstable and Walton if they agree to take part, and the draw will be made as usual at this year's SEBA A.G.M.

In recent years, the number of tournaments organised with the scratch bowler in mind has almost disappeared. To rectify this situation an number of bowlers in the London area have got together and formed "The Scratch Bowlers Club". Its aim is to promote tournament and competitive play for the higher average bowler, the club will run at least 8 tournaments a year, ranging from singles events through doubles, trios and if membership numbers permit, even 5 and 6 man team events.
