In the Junior 4 person team event the only stipulation is that all players have to be 18 or under but at least two have to be under 16. The Bexleyheath team were victorious in this event. Their players, Matt Gear, Janet Sellars, Adam Fuller and James Knapp all bowled really well. James Knapp rolled games of 201,180 and 195 giving him a 576 series, highest junior series of the day. Janet Sellars achieved the second highest series of the day with a 560 series including a 211 game. The other team members Matt Gear and Adam Fuller scored 489 and 498 respectively. The Whitstable quartet, Joe Cooper, Hannah Kohler, Harry Steen and Craig Lambkin, came second with a 1994 team series. Craig Lambkin was their high man with the fourth highest junior series of 543.

Gravesend did not enter a junior team because AMF Gravesend does not have a Y.B.C. A pacer team was used to make up numbers for the competition.

The last event to finish was the adult 5 person team event. Although there are no handicaps used in this competition for the team event, the players have to fulfil certain criteria. One player will be in the 199 or under average slot, one in 189 or under, 1 in 179 or under, 1 in 169 or under and 1 in 159 or under.

Chatham came first in this event with Bexleyheath, who were drawn on the same pair of lanes, finishing in second place. The Chatham Team, Wayne Shaw, Gary Kerr, Anne Whitehead, Keith Hecken and Justin Shaw, started strongly with a 915 team game featuring a 201 game from Gary Kerr. Their second game was highest team game of the event with a fabulous 974, Keith Hecken contributing a brilliant 243 and Justin Shaw a 203 game. The team finished with an 817 team game, giving them a team series of 2706. Anchorman, Justin Shaw was their highest scorer on 580 with Keith Hecken close behind on 574.

Bexleyheath finished with a 2652 team series. Their highest team game being the second when they achieved 917. This included a 207 game from Michael Foord and a 221 from their anchorman, Peter Rogers. Peter Rogers achieved a 628 series (joint second highest of the day) with games of 196, 221 and 211.

After each team had dropped their lowest points score the final positions were

1ST WHI - 40 PTS, 2ND BEX - 38, 3RD CLI - 31, 4TH CHA - 26, 5TH GRA - 15, 6TH MAR- 14.

WHI had the highest team average of 175.9. BEX 2nd with 174.9 and CHA 3rd with 169.0

In concluding an excellent day's bowling, the tournament manager, Jerry Moll presented the Kent Messenger Trophy to Whitstable's team manager, Nathan Clark. Bexleyheath's team manager, Lesley Pateman, was presented with a runners up certificate.

In the Peewee Division young Louie Long, who is himself a new member of the Club and who stepped in only a couple of weeks before the competition to replace a bowler who had to withdraw, went straight in with a new high game of 138, and his new high series of 356 won him a bronze medal. The brilliant 487 series from our Junior girl, Lesley Waters, also won her a bronze medal in her division. There were narrow medal misses from Emily Frost (5th - Graduate Girl), Kirsty Belchem (4th - Senior Girl) and Hannah Frost (5th - Bantam Girl); also Sarah Hewett bowled her personal best series of 323 in the Bantam Girls Division. Our golden girl on the day was Zoe Oldham, her new personal best series of 467 series put her in 1st place in the Bantam Girls Division and she became our first gold medal winner and National Champion of the Tournament.

On to the Doubles - Chloe Monks and Chelsie Pyle, in the Intermediate Girls Division (BOTH hitting a 519 series!) finished in 2nd place winning a fantastic silver medal. In the Girls Bantam Division, once again Zoe Oldham (373) and Hannah Frost (409) totalling 782 together, made it a second gold medal for Whitstable and the pair were National Champions once again, (two years ago they won the Peewee Division). Hannah Kohler (569) and Kirsty Belchem (579) Senior Girls, with their 1148 Doubles total made it a second winning team - it was gold for Kirsty and Hannah and so another pair of National Champions in the Club!

Then it was back to the Hotels for food and an early night - it was all to play for in the Team Event the following day.

The atmosphere was 'loud' and anticipation was high; the Long brothers, bowling in the 'Hot Shots' team, inspired by their performances in the Singles, went a step further in the team event, Louie increasing his high game to 144 and Jack increasing his series to 354. Sam Briant, bowling in the Master Blasters, made mum Shirley shed a tear or two by hitting a two new highs - a 193 game and 515 series! Absolutely FANTASTIC!

The Pintastics team had high expectations; Hannah Kohler, Chelsie Pyle, Natasha Krajewska and Emily Frost all bowled well and Kirsty Belchem, who had been so consistent all weekend, bowled a fabulous 614 series, contributing to a team total of 2671 and a bronze medal for the girls in the female team event.

Now Dave, as you know, has a bit of a soft spot for the 'young ones' and he had been building the Peewee Team up for the last six months - the trophy is huge he would say and how confident he was that they could bring it home- well they believed in him and in themselves and they did it. Including a new high game of 172 for Michel Baker, the team total of 1847 for the Whitstable Dynamites; Michael Baker, Reece Monks, Lee Pyle, Zoe Oldham and Hannah Frost; was enough for yet another gold medal and National title for Whitstable YBC.

And as if this wasn't impressive enough, there was more to come in the All Events. Kirsty picked up a silver medal in the Senior Girls Division for her 1778 total, that is a fabulous 197.6 average over her nine games and she was to be Whitstable's high average bowler of the tournament. Hannah Frost kept up her successful Nationals with a silver to add to her two golds she had already won. However the day - the tournament - belonged to young Zoe, her 1276 All Events total, that is a 141.8 average over her nine games, won her a place among the *elite*, it was to win her her fourth gold medal of the tournament. She had won every event she had entered and her smile said it all!!!!!!!!

Many many congratulations Zoe on a magnificent achievement - Whitstable YBC is very proud of you!

And talking of pride, it was a good feeling to see our own Emily Frost as part of the Junior England Squad helping with the medal presentation - giving out medals and kisses to the winners (Louie certainly didn't object to either!).
