KTBA AGM.

Following a discussion regarding the 2021 Virtual AGM Guidance email received from the BTBA. Two main areas raised concerns.

- 1) The drop in membership numbers.
- 2) Membership fee options. It was felt that the options offered so that members could vote at the AGM seem impractical / unfair. Paying £12.50 now and making up the balance when a member starts bowling again, is the same as paying for a standard membership now. The alternative is to apply for the £12.50 membership now and pay the full standard fee once bowling recommences, this means paying an additional £12.50 in the interim until bowling resumes.

It was therefore unanimously agreed to defer the KTBA AGM provisionally until February 2022.
